

SPRING 2022 YOUTH VOICE REPORT

Melton, Woodbridge & Deben Peninsula

This term, Youth Voice asked the young people of the area what they like about where they live, and what needs to be improved. An excellent response from young people across the area this term means we are able to take the issues raised to the right people and seek solutions where possible.



53% of the responses related to infrastructure improvements.

Although we have limited influence over some of the issues raised, such as a lack of shops, there are some potential opportunities to work alongside partners to raise these issues and challenge them to take action. The young people surveyed also expressed concerns around amenities for older people, with some saying that curbs and cobbles down the Thoroughfare are not wheelchair friendly

Safety walking home from school, not enough pavements, and bad lighting in winter (especially in rural areas) were all concerns expressed this term. Students also noted the issue of walking to school 'through a cloud of vape smoke'.
