

Photographic competition terms and conditions

Entries may be submitted through the following methods:

- By tagging @eastsuffolkcouncils into an Instagram post between 24 July – 4 September
- By adding # to an Instagram or Twitter post between 24 July – 4 September
- By emailing communications@eastsuffolk.gov.uk

Entries must meet the following criteria:

- Entries must not have been a winner in another photographic competition
- Entries must be taken within east Suffolk - details of where it was taken should be provided if possible.
- Entries must have been taken since 1st January 2017
- It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.
- Anyone pictured in the submitted image has agreed to their image being used. For anyone pictured under the age of 18, parent/guardian permission must be given.
- Entries must be submitted between 00:01 on Monday 24 July and 23:59 on Monday 4 September. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Entries must be relevant to one of the following categories:
 - o Living in east Suffolk
 - o Working in east Suffolk
 - o Explore east Suffolk
 - o Under 16s
- Entries in the Under 16s category must have been taken by people aged 16 or under.
- Emailed entries must be high resolution.
- We regret that we cannot accept postal entries
- Entrants can enter a maximum of 3 images in total.
- Copyright in all images submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, in consideration of their providing entry to the competition, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to Suffolk Coastal and Waveney District Councils to feature any or all of the submitted images in any of their publications, their websites and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition.
- By entering the competition, entrants grant the Councils free of charge irrevocable licence to reproduce, enlarge, publish or exhibit the photo on any media for a period of 2 years after the closing date. This may include coverage in the press, online, on social media or to promote subsequent competitions.
- Judging will take place in October and the judges decision is final.
- One winner and one runner-up will be chosen for each category. Winners will be informed directly and announced through social media , press and online coverage.
- Prizes will be given only to the winner and runner-up in each category. The prizes will be as below:
 - o A framed copy of the photo
 - o The photo to be displayed in East Suffolk House and/or Riverside, either in print or digitally and at the Councils discretion
 - o A £20 shopping voucher for the winner in each category only.

Submitting an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of the above conditions.
