- 7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 18 March 2020.
- 8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday, 26 March 2020. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 18 March 2020. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 18 March 2020.
