## **Review of Parliamentary Polling Districts and Polling Places**

- In compliance with Section 17 of the Electoral Administration Act 2013, Suffolk
  Coastal and Waveney District Councils are required to conduct a review of those
  parliamentary polling districts and polling places within the Suffolk Coastal, Waveney
  and part of the Central Suffolk and North Ipswich Parliamentary Constituency. The
  review will be conducted between 8 October 2018 and 30 November 2018.
- 2. The Acting Returning Officer is required to make representations to the Councils, which must include information as to the location of polling stations within existing and/or proposed polling places.
- 3. Any elector within the District may make representations concerning either the existing, or proposed arrangements (when published) as to the accessibility with regard to all electors within a particular polling district.
- 4. Representations should, where possible, give alternative locations to consider.

- 7. Final recommendations will be considered by the Councils at a meeting on 28 January 2019. Changes will take effect from 1 February 2019.
