



Lunchtime stride and pick report 19.3.2018

In a rapid 45 minute pick staff from Hoseasons and Waveney District Council volunteered their time and picked three full bags of litter, with more to do during a future lunchtime. The weather was fair but windy. Our route took us alongside a small part of B1531 and Durban Street.

The main items of litter found were:

• Food and drink packaging - bottles both glass and plastic, sweets and crisps packaging, polystyrene food trays, straws from drink cartons, drinks cans (particularly energy drinks)

The most unusual items were an unopened drinks bottle and tin of sardines and a sponge.

This staff pick and stride, part of the Great British Spring Clean promoted by Keep Britain Tidy, was originally organised for 5th March but had to be postponed due to snow. It was organised by Waveney District Council on behalf of the Greenprint Forum as part of the Year of #PlasticAction. It launches the provision of sticks and bags at Riverside to enable staff and managers to get fit and clean up during their lunch breaks.
