

## Photographic competition terms and conditions

Entries may be submitted by emailing [communications@eastsoffolk.gov.uk](mailto:communications@eastsoffolk.gov.uk) or through Instagram using #eastsoffolk2019

Entries must meet the following criteria:

- Entries must not have been a winner or runner-up in another photographic competition, including the 2018 East Suffolk Photo Competition
- Entries must be taken within East Suffolk - details of where it was taken should be provided if possible.
- Entries must have been taken since 1 January 2019
- It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit have been taken with the permission of the subject and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.
- Anyone pictured in the submitted image has agreed to their image being used. For anyone pictured under the age of 18, parent/guardian permission must be given.
- Entries must be submitted between 00:01 on Friday 1 November and 23:59 on Saturday 30 November 2019. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Emailed entries must be high resolution.
- We regret that we cannot accept postal entries
- Entrants can enter a maximum of 3 images in total.
- Copyright in all images submitted for this competition remains with the respective entrants. However, in consideration of their providing entry to the competition, each entrant grants a worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual licence to East Suffolk Council to feature any or all of the submitted images in any of their publications, their websites and/or in any promotional material connected to this competition.
- Judging will take place in December and the judges' decision is final.
- The judges will choose a first, second and third place winner with a maximum of two 'highly commended'. Winners will be informed directly and announced through social media, press and online coverage.
- Prizes will be as follows:
  - The 3 winners will each receive an e-shopping voucher worth £50.00
  - The highly commended winners will each receive an e-shopping voucher worth £20.00
- Submitting an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of the above conditions.
