## **Deben Leisure Centre is here!**

## Your new Deben Leisure Centre is open for business



Deben Leisure Centre is open for business after undergoing a £3.5 million refurbishment, bringing state-of-the-art leisure facilities to Woodbridge.

The centre was closed in September 2017 and is the first project to be completed in Suffolk Coastal's five year programme to improve leisure facilities and encourage more people to become active and fit.

The enhanced leisure centre includes a spacious gym with 58 stations and the latest equipment.

There are two new studios for interactive group cycling and group exercise. These are also available for community hire.

A new thermal suite is accessible from the pool area and features a steam room, sauna and ice feature as well as a relaxation area.

The new facility was designed with with the Council's development partner, Pulse Build & Design, and will be run by our operational partners, Places Leisure.

#### Deben goes green

East Green Energy have designed and installed 90 Solar PV Panels on the roof of Deben.

The centre will benefit from up to 24.75kw of renewable electricity which will help power the lights, equipment, thermal suite and swimming pool.

Any used electricity will be fed back into the grid to help power other homes in and around Woodbridge.

## In other leisure news

# £3.5 million upgrade for Leiston Leisure Centre gets the go ahead



Suffolk Coastal is bringing state-of-the-art leisure to Leiston, after plans for a £3.5 million refurbishment was given the go ahead.

Work is due to start in September 2018. The centre will need to be fully closed for four months to undergo structual work, with the pool due to reopen in January 2019, and the whole centre expected to be fully open in summer 2019.

The new facility will be given an extension and feature a large gym with modern equipment, including zones for cardiovascular, strength and resistance.

The reception area will have a coffee shop and a soft play area for children, which will provide a great view of the pool.

A new thermal suite, featuring a sauna and

steam room, a feature shower and a relaxation area, will be accessible from the pool area.

There will be more fitness classes available with two new dance studios and a group cycling studio, which will also serve as multibookable rooms.

The two squash courts has been retained in the new plan after the feedback we received from the local squash club and other users.

Our operators, Places Leisure will be contacting members of Leiston Leisure Centre over the coming months to discuss available options to them during the closure.
