It will mean that small time builders or self builders will be priced out ,leaving only large scale developers .Particularly when building lower priced housing for the first time market .

Why charge more for areas such as Aldeburgh when those are exactly the places that need low cost housing. How can you justify charging for extensions when it has no impact on infrastructure? How can you treat large multi national building companies the same as a self employed builder, does that seem fair?
