

Community Infrastructure Levy Draft Charging Schedule

Representation period:

9am Friday 5th October to 4pm Friday 16th November 2012 (6 weeks)

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended), the Draft Charging Schedule has been published. The Council invites representations prior to Submission for independent examination.

The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a new standard charge which local authorities in England and Wales can charge on most types of new development in their area. CIL charges will be based on the size, type and location of the development proposed. The money raised will be used to pay for infrastructure required to support development in the District.

The Draft Charging Schedule sets out the Council's proposed rates of CIL in the area for which it is the Charging Authority. The Council is the Charging Authority for the entire District excluding the area covered by the Broads Authority.
