How to respond:

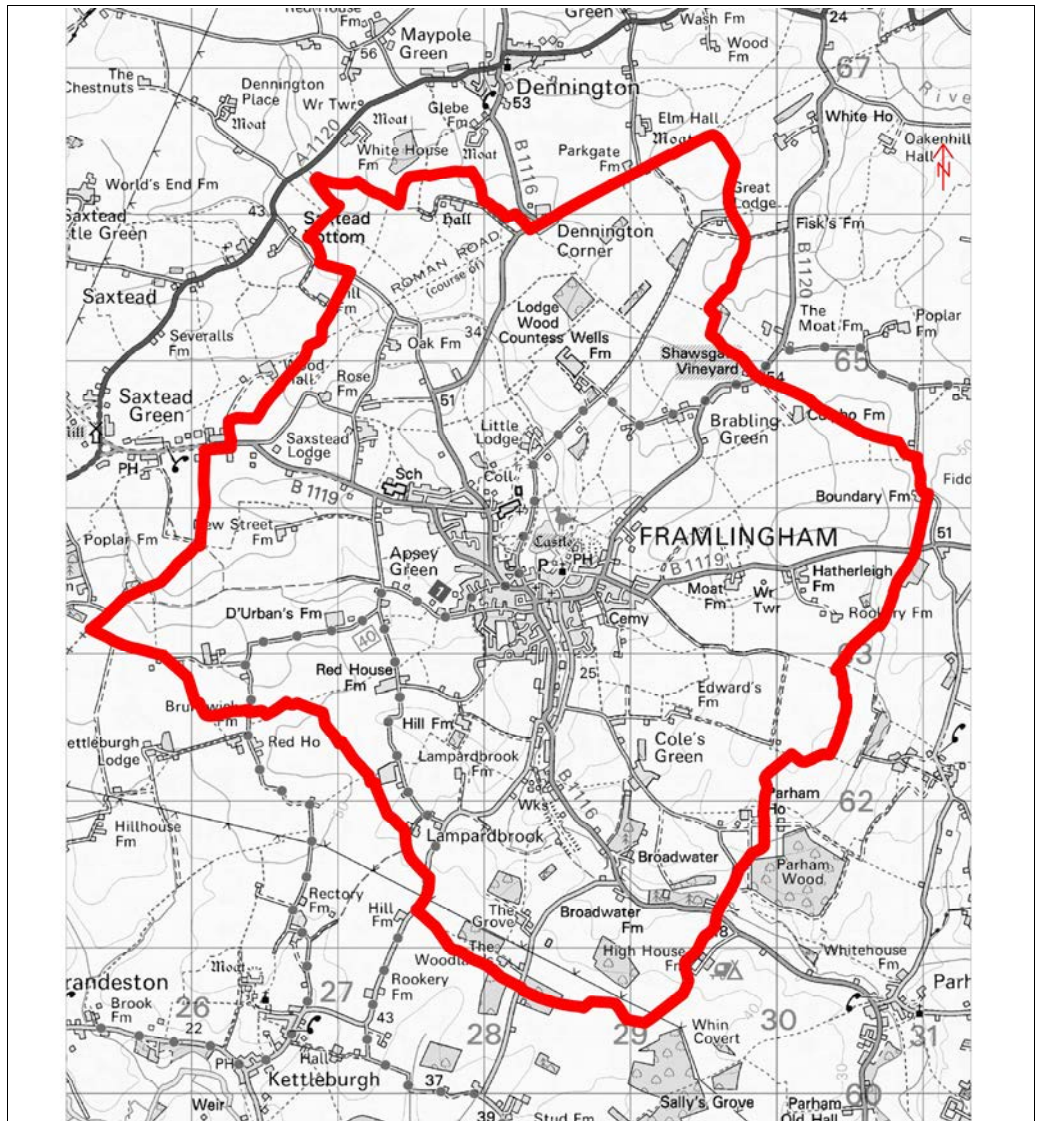
