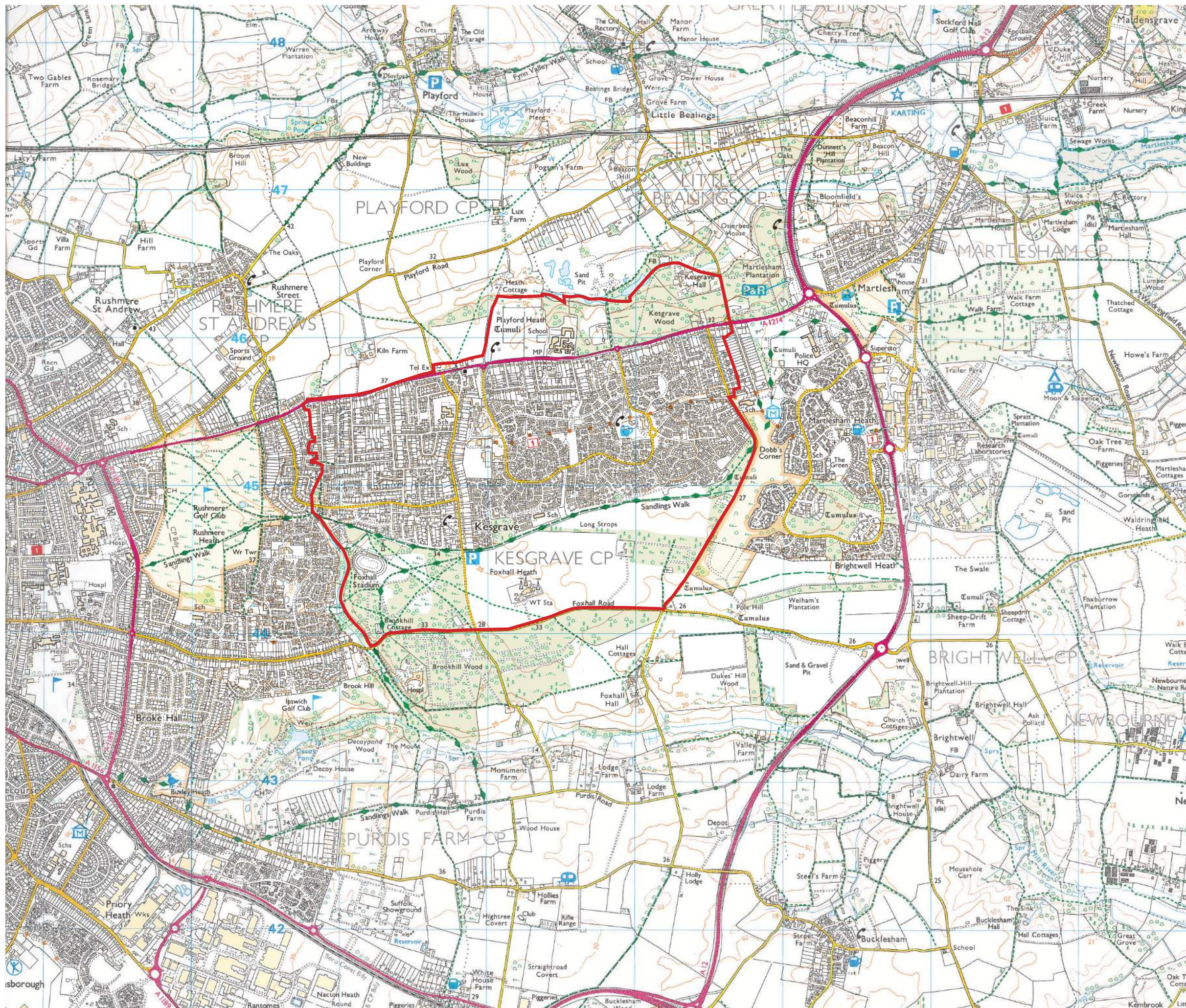

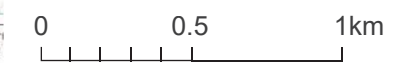

 Kesgrave Neighbourhood Plan boundary



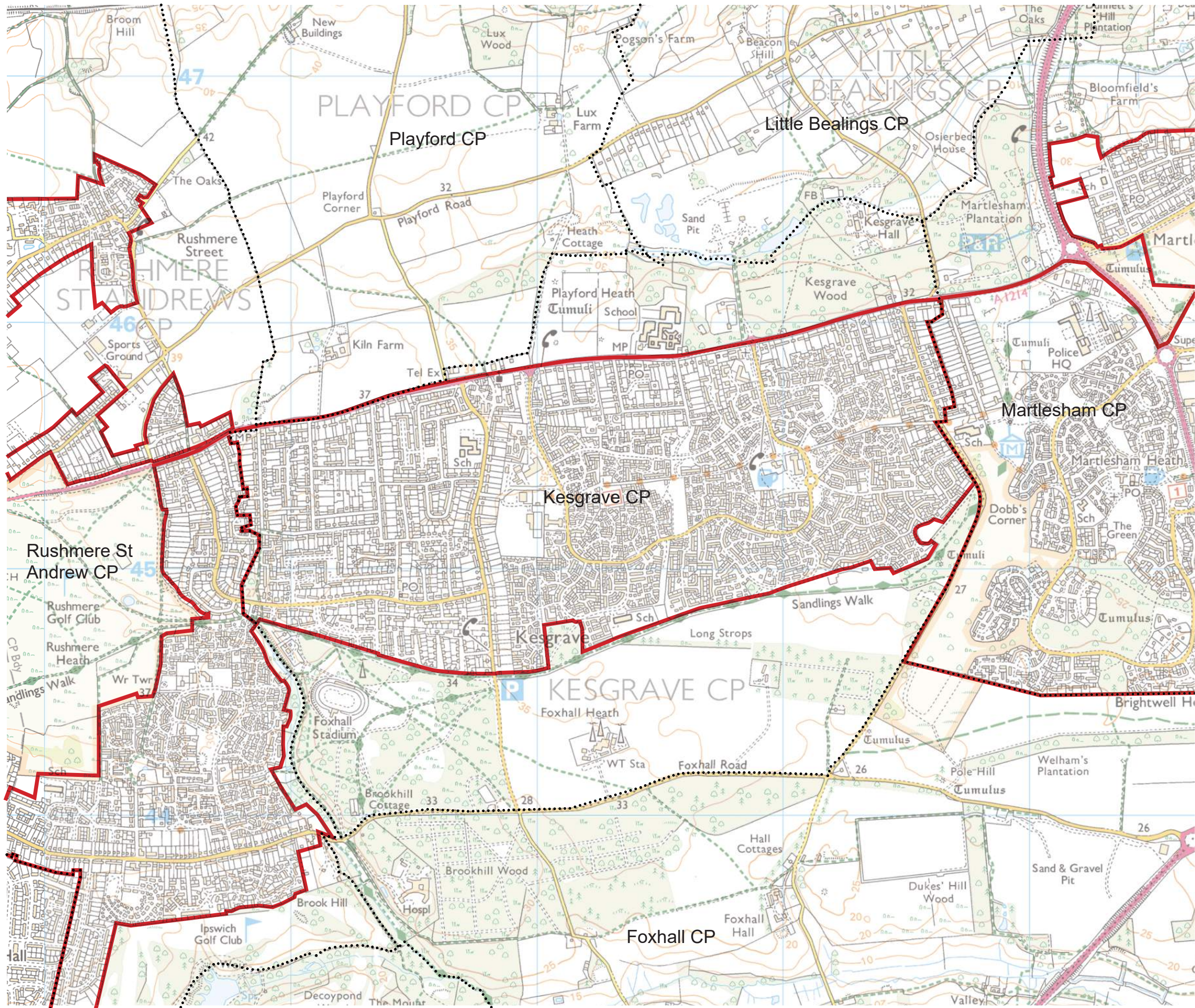

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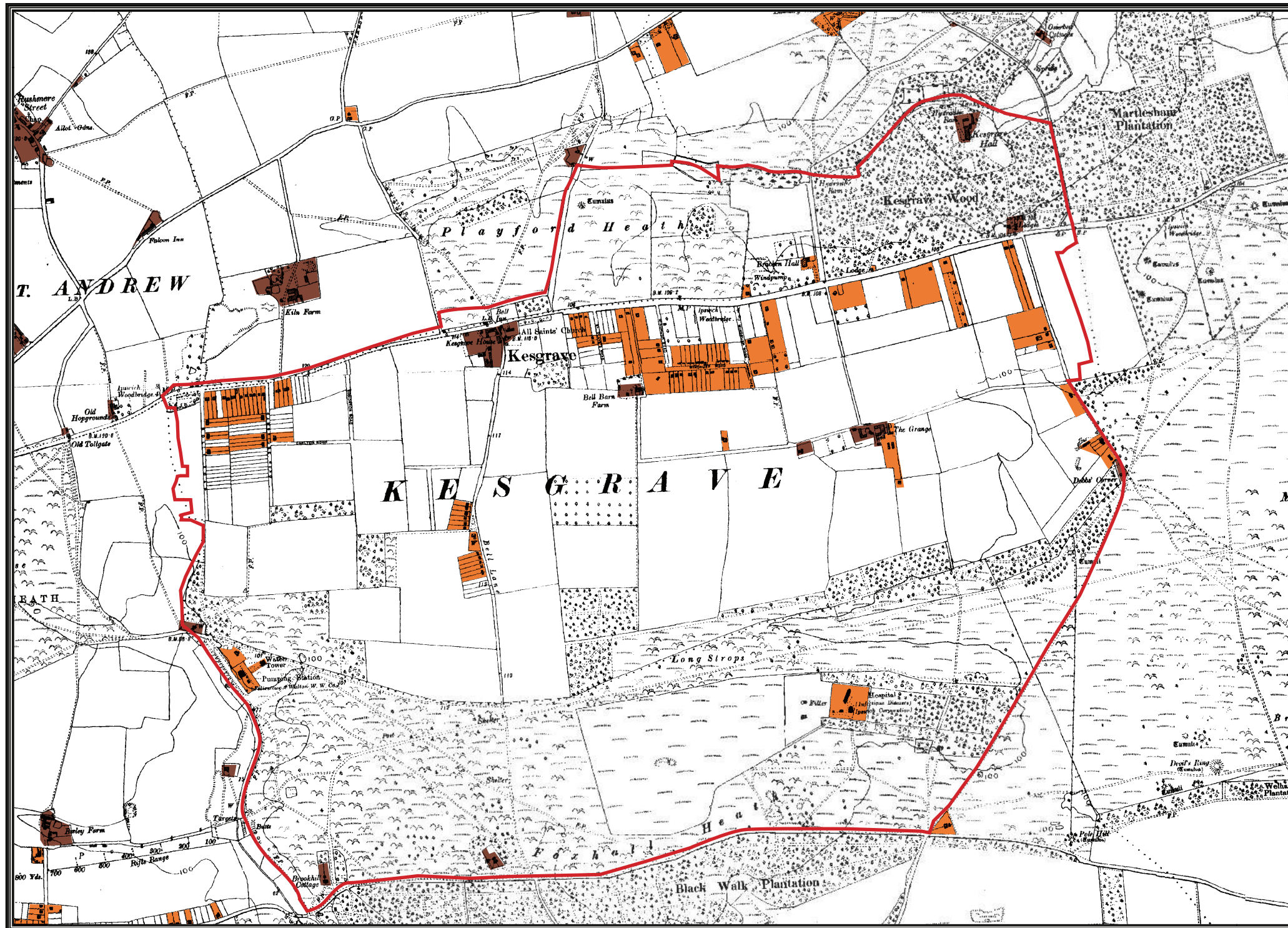

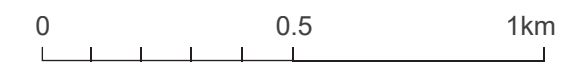

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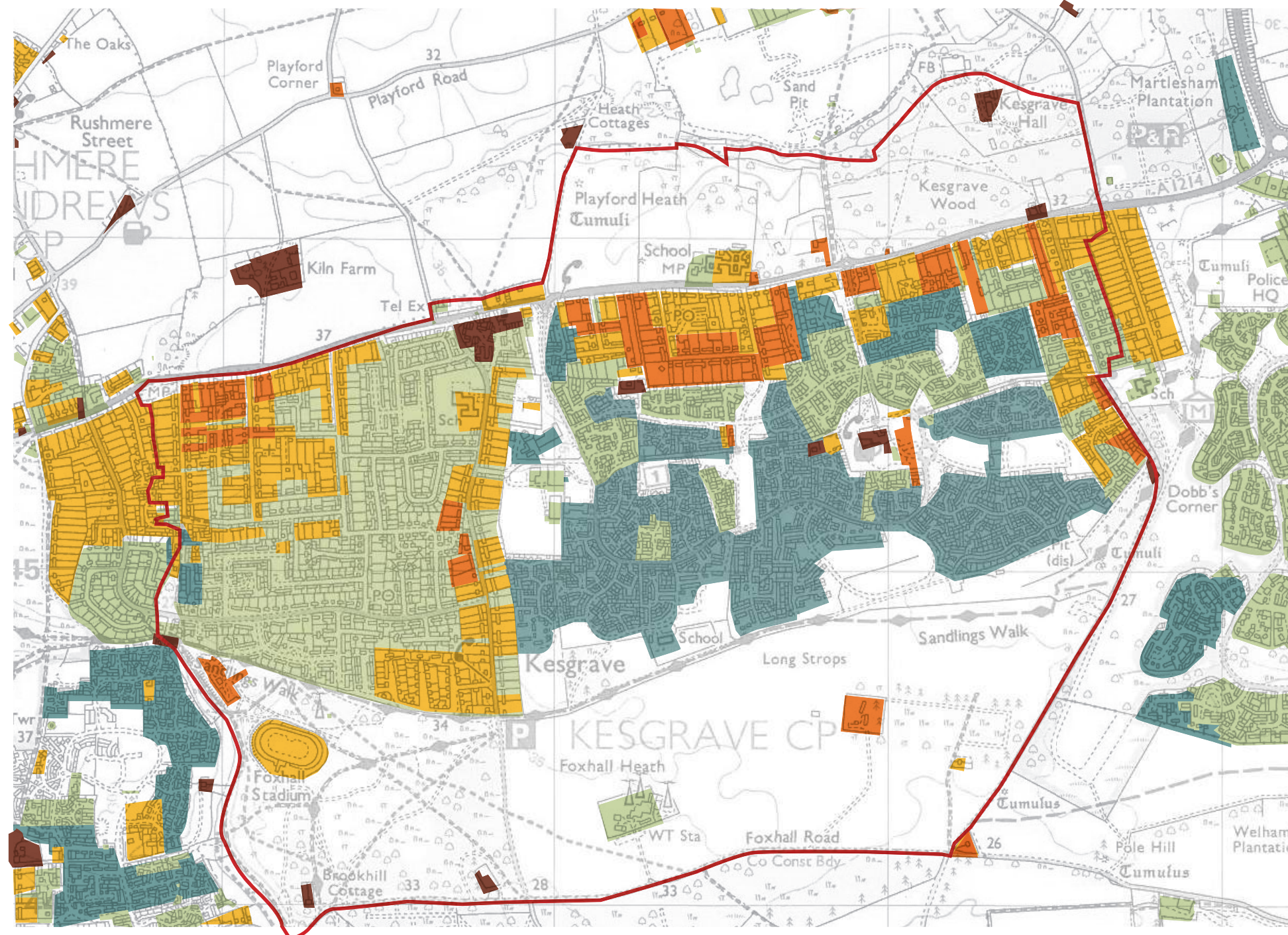


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OS Plan 1:10,560 1957-1958

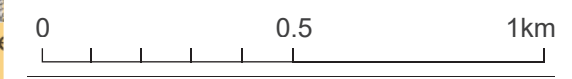

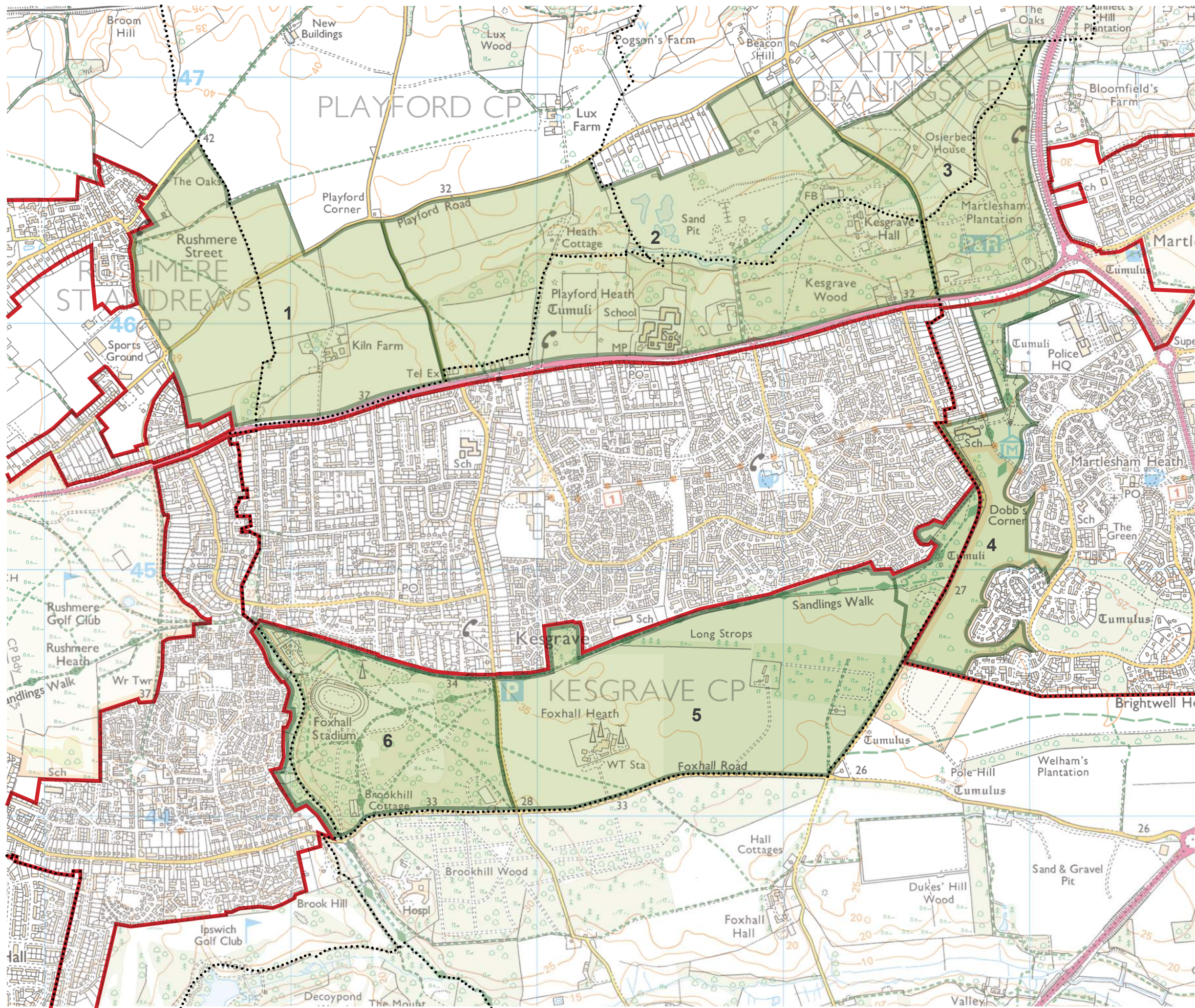

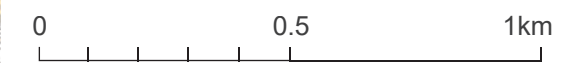

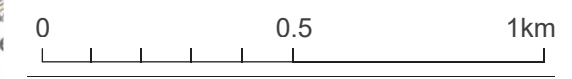

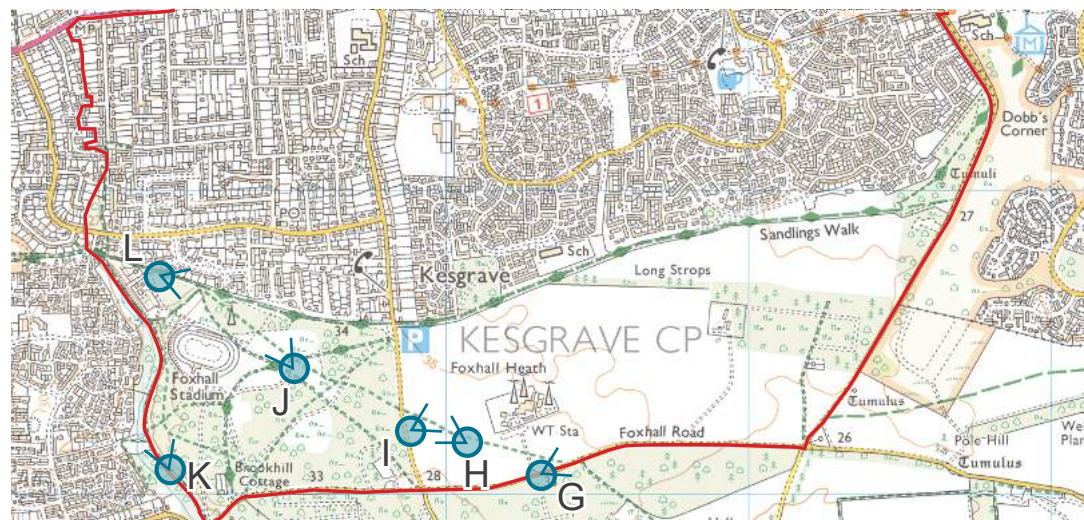

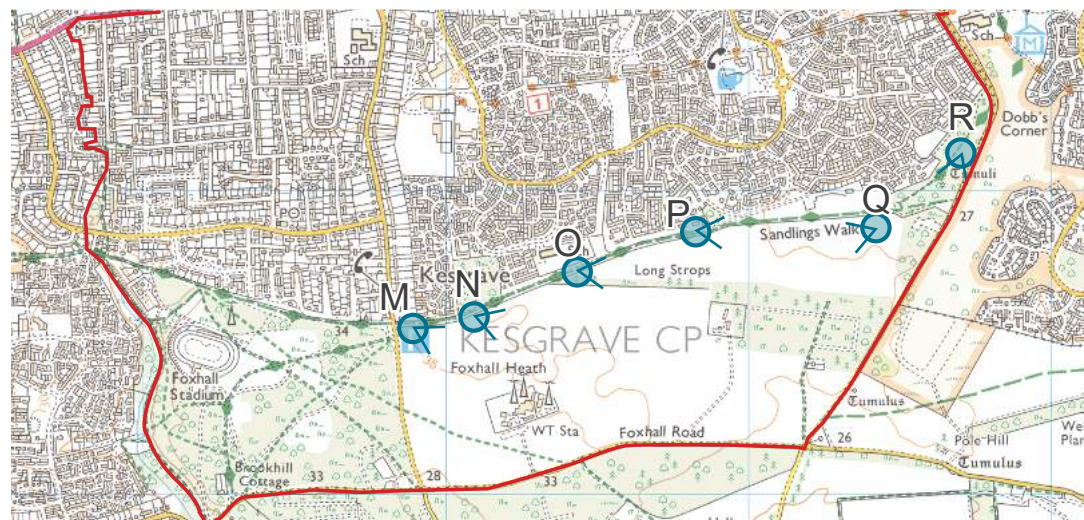

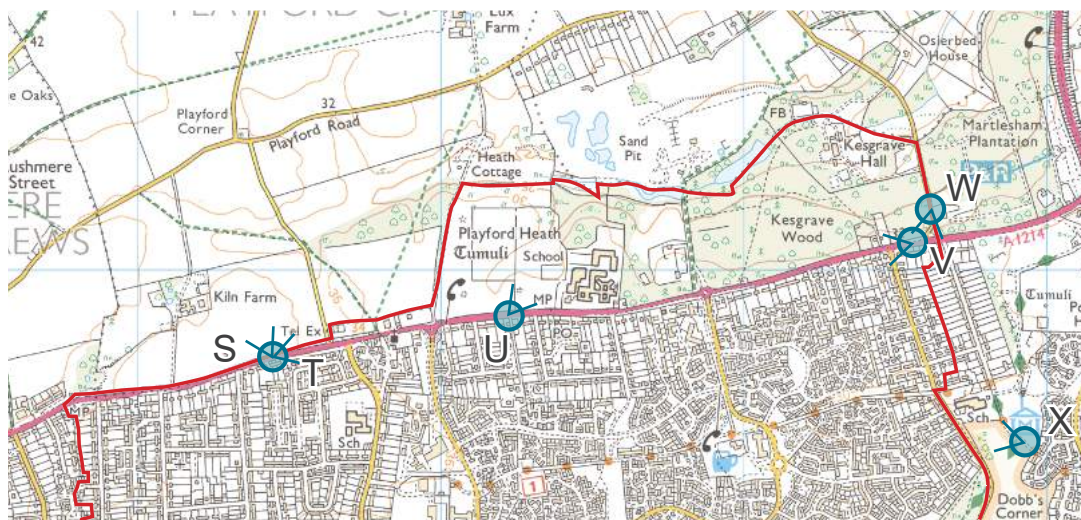

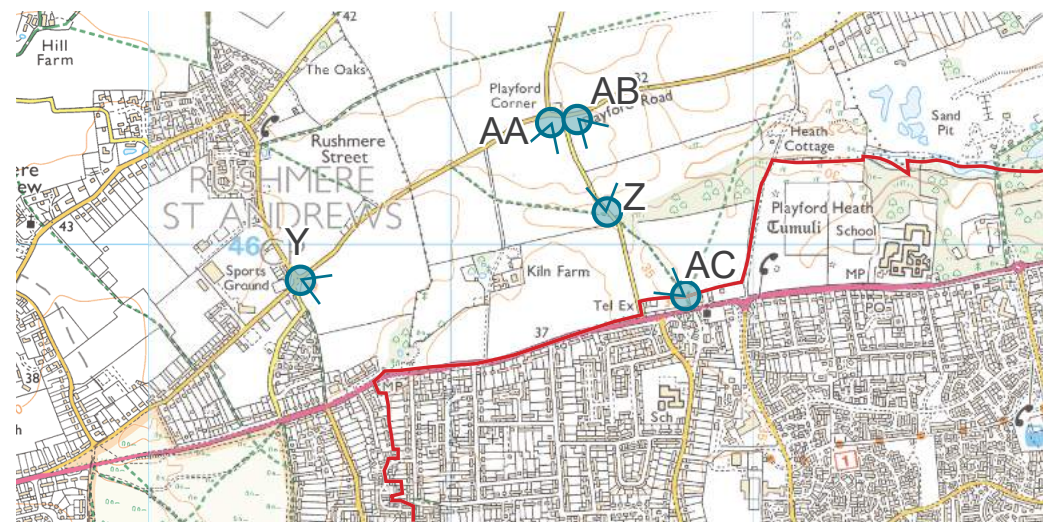

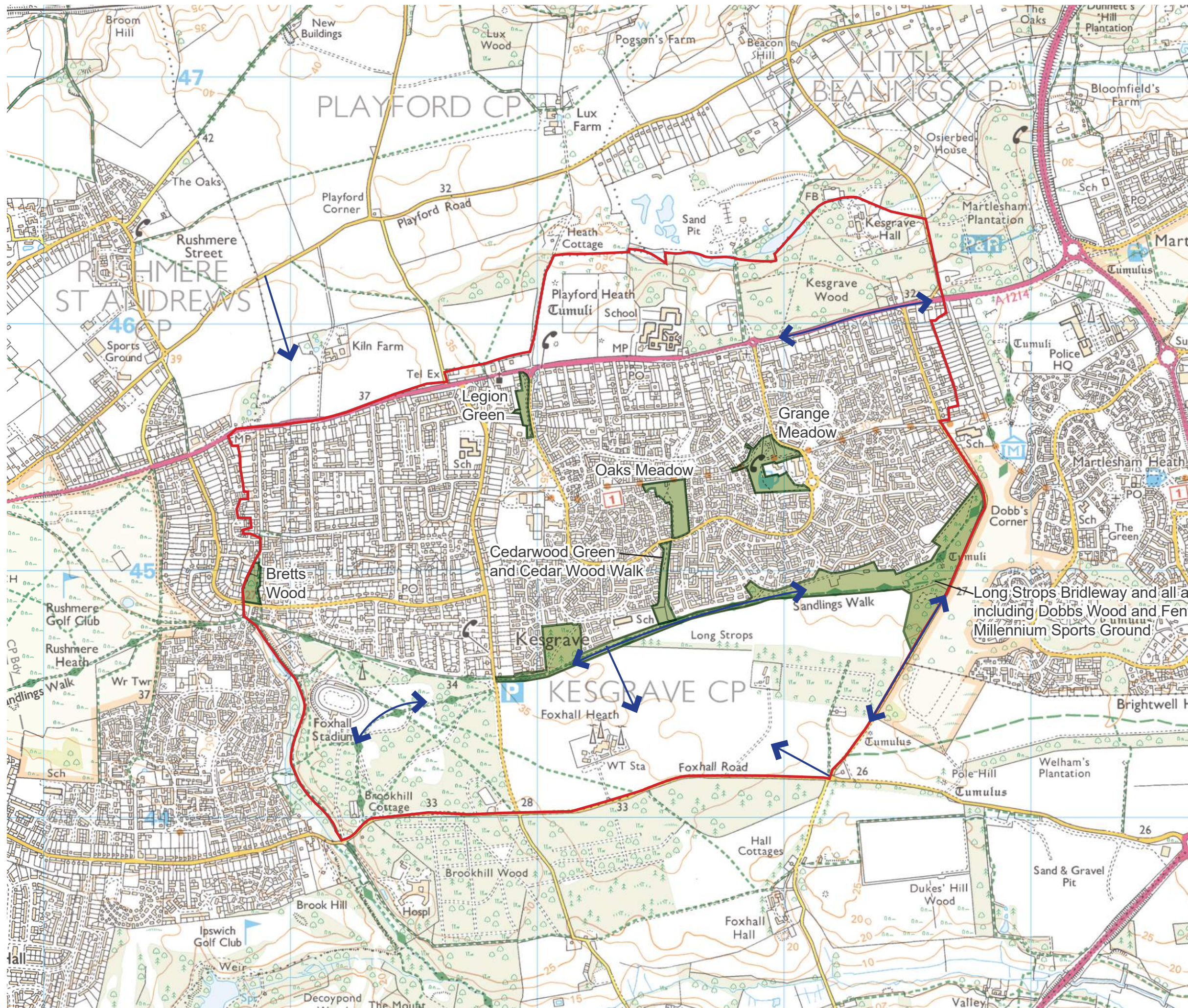

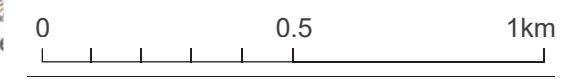
