

Reydon Neighbourhood Plan

Extended Consultation period: 27th February to 5pm 8th May 2020

Reydon Parish Council have submitted their Neighbourhood Plan to East Suffolk Council ahead of it being submitted for independent examination. East Suffolk Council is required to publicise the plan and invite representations, which will be forwarded to the examiner for consideration alongside the plan. Please note, the period for representations was originally planned to close on 9th April 2020, however in response to Covid-19 restrictions this period has been extended to 5pm on 8th May 2020.

Subject to the plan successfully completing all the relevant regulatory stages, the policies and proposals contained in the plan will be used by East Suffolk Council in the determination of planning applications within the Reydon Neighbourhood Area.

Where can the Plan be inspected?

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, hard copies are no longer available for inspection in public locations, but they are now available to be sent to you on request. How should I submit my representation?

All representations should be headed Reydon Neighbourhood Plan as the subject matter. Where representations relate to a particular paragraph or policy please ensure that this is also clearly stated. Any representations made may include a request to be notified of East Suffolk Council's decision whether to accept the Examiners' recommendation and future progress with the plan.

When must I submit my representation by?

Representations must be received no later than 5pm on 8th May 2020. All representations will be made available to view online as soon as possible after the close of the consultation.
