Our family live on Seckford Heights in Woodbridge.

We have received a note from Martlesham Neighbourhood Plan Team advising that Woodbridge TC is seeking to include Seckford Heights within its Neighbourhood Plan although it is presently within the Martlesham Neighbourhood boundary.

We think Woodbridge TC is correct in its assertion that Seckford Heights should be included in the Woodbridge Neighbourhood because we agree that Seckford Heights is a continuation of the urban area of Woodbridge whereas there is a clear physical separation of Seckford Heights from Martlesham by the open land to the south of Ipswich Road.

Also, the village sign for Martlesham is on Top St which is to the south of the mini roundabout on Ipswich Road, some considerable distance away from Seckford Heights.

A further point to bear in mind is that some 10 years ago, the Seckford Heights residents voted to have their postal addresses changed by the Royal Mail to have "Martlesham" replaced by "Woodbridge" as the previous reference to Martlesham was causing confusion as delivery drivers were going to Martlesham and then being unable to find any of the roads within Seckford Heights.
