1. Research work on the B1122

Suffolk County Council's research into the community's perception of impacts associated with the potential Sizewell C construction traffic on communities along the B1122 is progressing well. Around 140 face to face interviews have been completed, complemented by an online survey, which has attracted a similar number of respondents. A final stage of the research will take place in February and parishioners of Yoxford, Middleton and Theberton/Eastbridge will be contacted shortly in relation to this. This work will be used to support the local authorities' response to EDF's Stage 2 consultation.

2. Suffolk's Energy Gateway - Lowestoft to Ipswich
