

APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO USE THE SUFFOLK HISTORIC LANDSCAPE CHARACTERISATION DATA

Suffolk County Council (SCC) grants non-exclusive and non-transferable licences for the use and reproduction of the Suffolk HLC. There is a handling charge of £30+VAT for licences.

The map exists as a computer-based Geographic Information System (GIS) map table in MapInfo format, but can also be supplied in MapInfo Interchange Format for import into other GIS formats.

Terms and conditions

- a) No adaptation, alteration or manipulation of the information contained within the Suffolk HLC map is permitted
- b) The permission is restricted to the licensee and cannot be assigned, transferred or sub-licensed without the prior written permission of SCC.
- c) The HLC data was created using an underlying Ordnance Survey map base. Ordnance Survey copyright should be acknowledged by the addition of the appropriate copyright statement on any maps produced using the data.
- d) The Licensee shall use the supplied dataset only for the purposes stated in its application.
- e) The use of the HLC data is licensed only for the period of time specified in the Licence Schedule.
- f) Title, copyright and all proprietary rights in the HLC dataset are reserved by SCC and are protected by Copyright Law. SCC reserves all rights of ownership and copyright in the dataset.
- g) SCC retains the right to terminate licence agreements at anytime by giving 30 days written notice.
