Waveney Local Plan

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

The Waveney Local Plan was adopted by Waveney District Council on 20th March 2019.

The Waveney Local Plan covers the former Waveney Local Planning Authority area. The Local Plan sets out the level of growth which needs to be planned in the area and identifies where that growth should be located and how it should be delivered. The Local Plan sets out the planning policies which the Council will use to determine planning applications in the Waveney area. The Waveney Local Plan covers the period 2014-2036.

The Local Plan was subject to independent examination, including public hearing sessions, by a Government appointed Planning Inspector. The Inspector's report was received on 1st March 2019. The Inspector recommended a number of main modifications were made to make the Plan sound. These modifications have been included in the adopted Local Plan. The Waveney Local Plan carries full weight in the consideration of planning applications and appeal decisions.

The Waveney Local Plan wholly supersedes the following documents which are no longer part of the development plan for the Waveney area:

- Core Strategy (adopted 2009)
- Development Management Policies (adopted 2011)
- Site Specific Allocations (adopted 2011)
- Lowestoft Lake Lothing and Outer Harbour Area Action Plan (adopted 2012)

Any person aggrieved by the Local Plan may make an application under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Act to the High Court on the grounds that the Plan is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made within six weeks of the date of the 21st March 2019.
