THE SUFFOLK COASTAL DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET
PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION) ORDER 2010

The Suffolk Coastal District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32, 35 and 101 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and all other enabling powers and with the consent of Suffolk County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order.

PART 1: PRELIMINARY

1. **Title**

This Order may be cited as the Suffolk Coastal District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Variation) Order 2010.

2. **Commencement and Effect**

This Order shall come into operation on the nineteenth day of April 2010.

Save as varied by this Order the Suffolk Coastal District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2008 ("the 2008 Order") shall continue in full force and effect.

With effect from the nineteenth day of April 2010 the 2008 Order shall have effect with the following variations.

PART 2: AMENDMENTS

3. The Schedules to the 2008 Order shall no longer have effect and are replaced by Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order.
4. The tariffs in force in each parking place listed or identified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall have effect as shown in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. All charged car parks except Sizewell Beach are charged all year as shown in Schedule 1 to this Order.
6. The charged days are extended to include Sundays in Crescent Road, Highfield Road and Ranelagh Road car parks in Felixstowe and all car parks in Woodbridge as shown in Schedule 1 to this Order.
7. The Avenue in Woodbridge is brought into line by charging every day and from 8:00 until 18:00 as shown in Schedule 1 to this Order.
8. Beach Hut permits are available to Suffolk Coastal District Council beach hut owners at an annual cost of £55. Each beach hut is eligible for one permit only which is valid in the

relevant specified car park only and must be displayed in the Motor Vehicle to which it relates.

9. Wireless Green, Felixstowe is added to Schedule 1 as a car park. The limits of this parking place are shown for identification on the Map no. 1 annexed hereto.
10. The 2008 Order is amended by varying the limits of the parking place at Oak Lane, Woodbridge as shown in the Map no.2 annexed hereto.
11. The 2008 Order is amended by varying the limits of the parking place at Station Road, Woodbridge as shown in the Map no. 3 annexed hereto.
12. The 2008 Order is amended by varying the limits of the Coach and Lorry Park at Station Road, Woodbridge as shown in the Map no. 4 annexed hereto.
13. Four new car parks at Landguard, Felixstowe are added to Schedule 1. The limits of these parking places are shown for identification on the Maps no. 5 to 8 inclusive annexed hereto.
14. The 2008 Order is amended by varying the limits of the Leisure Centre, Felixstowe as shown in the Map no. 9 annexed hereto.
15. The 2008 Order is amended by varying the limits of the car park at Oakley Square, Aldeburgh as shown in the Map no. 10 annexed hereto.
16. In respect of parking places where the Council may issue permits for permit holders to park free of charge it may nevertheless request payment of an administration charge not exceeding £10.00.
17. If the holder of a season ticket or free permit requests issue of a replacement season ticket or free permit for any reason (e.g. if the season ticket or free permit first or subsequently issued has been lost or defaced) or for the issue of a new season ticket or free permit on acquisition of a new Motor Vehicle (or Motor-cycle) the Council may request payment of an administration charge not exceeding £10.00 before issue of a new or replacement season ticket or free permit.
18. Article 2 (a) of the 2008 Order is amended by the insertion of “Motorised caravans (small)” which means a motorised or self-propelled caravan, camper van, dormobile, motorhome or similar vehicle or other vehicle adapted for human habitation whether permanent or temporary under 5.5 metres (18 feet) in length and 2 metres (6.6 feet) width. These smaller motorhome are to be treated in the same way as cars as shown in Schedule 1. These vehicles must still park within bays; purchase a ticket for each bay occupied and must not cause an obstruction.
19. Caravans are allowed to park (but not to camp), at Station Road, Woodbridge as shown in Schedule 1 to this Order. Vehicles with caravans must still park within bays; purchase a ticket for each bay occupied and must not cause an obstruction.
20. Multi-day parking at The Avenue, Woodbridge is allowed as shown in Schedule 2 to this Order.

21. Suffolk Coastal aims to operate an enforcement regime which is 'customer-friendly'. In that context, there are instances where it is appropriate to cancel an ECN, but The Council may charge an administration fee to cover the administration costs. This is set at a maximum of £10.00.
22. Quarterly and Annual Season Tickets now have a start date and end date so there is no longer a restriction that they must start on the 1st day of any month.
23. A weekend-only season ticket is available at an annual price of £50 valid on weekends and bank holidays in all long-stay car parks except Church Street, Saxmundham as shown in Schedule 1 to this Order.
24. The following amendments are made to Schedule 1 to the 2008 Order, which is set out in full as revised in Schedule 1 hereto.
 1. Motorised caravans may park in the parking place at Slaughden Quay.
 2. The parking place at Convalescent Hill, Felixstowe is designated as a Long Stay car park (instead of Short/Long Stay).
 3. The parking places at Leiston High Street and Sizewell Road shall be assigned to tariff code 10 (instead of tariff code 9).
 4. The parking place at Saxmundham Market Place shall be assigned to tariff code 10 (instead of 9).
 5. The parking places at Wickham Market The Hill Long Stay and Short Stay shall be chargeable from 9.00am (instead of 8.00 am).
 6. At the parking place at Wickham Market The Hill Long Stay there shall be up to 10 parking spaces where parking shall be free for up to half an hour.
 7. The chargeable hours at Station Road Coach/Lorry Park are 24 hours Monday – Sunday inclusive. Parking for coaches is free between 10.00 and 22.00.
25. The following amendments are made to Schedule 2 to the 2008 Order, which is set out in full as revised in Schedule 2 hereto
 1. Tariff 17 is amended to include the 1-week visitor/tourist ticket (valid in all long stay car parks) and quarterly season ticket price is reduced from the short-stay price to the long-stay price.
 2. Annual (Short-Stay) season tickets are made available as shown in Schedule 2.
