(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER 2021

NOTICE is hereby given that East Suffolk Council has Made the above-named Order under sections 32, 34, 35, 39 and 124 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order is to amend the definitions of vehicle classifications, identify in which parking places they may park, and to add a new parking place located on Godyll Road, Southwold.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within six weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or of any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement in relation to the Order.
