Glass

Recycle at a glass bank. You can leave metal caps on!





Electricals and batteries

Contain precious and hazardous material. Don't put in your bin - take to a recycling point.





Textiles and clothes

Not accepted in the recycling bin.

Recycle at a textile bank or charity shop.







Food

Check if food can be placed in the garden waste bin. If not, food can be composted at home; check out our latest offers online.







Carrier bags/film

Recycle at a supermarket. Use re-usable bags.







Tetra Pak

Please don't put in your recycling bin. Where possible take to a recycling point.





Real Christmas Trees

These can be composted at home or appropriately sized sections can be placed in your garden waste bins.







Disposable nappies

Nappies must be placed in your residual waste bin. Every day substantial quantities of nappies are picked by hand from the recycling waste.
