Title: Approval of recommendation from the Enabling Communities Exemplar Grant Panel Meeting on 10 May 2018

Decisions Made by Cabinet Member with responsibility for Customers, Communities & Leisure: That the following applications in respect of applications for Enabling Communities Exemplar Programme be determined as follows:

Martlesham Parish Church Council – £9,058 conditional upon the applicant providing governance and policy documents, clarification of grant costs and addresses on quotes.

Westleton Village Hall – Deferred.

Aldeburgh Museum Charitable Trust – £5,000 conditional that the funds are used on the activities highlighted in the application.

Benhall and Sternfield Ex-Servicemen's Club and Village Hall – Deferred.

Wenhaston Village Hall Management Committee - £10,000 conditional upon securing the remainder of the match funding for the project.

Reason for Decision: The agreed allocation of grant aid is the most effective and efficient use of the funds available and is in accordance with the criteria of the Enabling Communities Exemplar Programme.
