Has oversight of activity across Lowestoft, to ensure coordinated and effective delivery of existing projects, and to identify gaps and opportunities and to drive forward new initiatives. Influences stakeholders to ensure there is sufficient resources and investment to deliver the programme. Provides a coordinated approach to the prioritisation of pipeline projects and provides a steer on future funding and investment priorities. Champions the potential Lowestoft has to contribute to County and Regional growth targets. Oversees the creation of an Investment Prospectus for Lowestoft.
