Title of Report	Allocations Policy: To approve proposed minor changes to the Policy
Report Reference	REP1746

Purpose of Report

To obtain approval to minor proposed changes to the Housing Allocations Policy, to ensure it will comply with the Homelessness Reduction Act 2017. The Act comes into force on the 3rd April 2018.

Options Considered

None. Without approval to amend the policy, the Council will not be able to fulfil it's duties to Homeless households in Waveney District Council and the Allocation Policy cannot be agreed as one policy which will cover all 8 Local Authorities in the Gateway Partnership.

Reason for Decision

The changes to the policy are necessary to meet the effect of legislative changes arising from the Homeless Reduction Act 2017. To ensure that the policy remains up-to-date, relevant, and contributes to the Council's ambitions for social housing and preventing and tackling homelessness.
