Summary

This e-learning course has been specifically written for taxi drivers. The course has been written so that the course conforms to licencing standards and has a set test that requires 80% of correct answers to pass the learning.

Aim

To increase the knowledge and understanding of safeguarding vulnerable adults and safeguarding children and people who may be at risk of child sexual exploitation.

Objectives

- During this course you will learn about safeguarding vulnerable adults.
- You will also learn about safeguarding children and child sexual exploitation.
- Taxi companies and taxi drivers can play an important part in spotting the signs that somebody might be at risk of abuse and in keeping people safe.
- During this course you will be made aware of some of the signs and indicators to look out for and how to report your concerns.
