

Emerging and developing enterprises

- **Suzi**: Has a passion for working with people with dementia. She is setting up her CME to offer personal care in the East Suffolk area.
- **Lydia**: Is a single parent, who thought about moving out of care and into something else, until she saw the programme and felt it was a natural fit.
- **Lisa**: 20 yrs. experience of care and support work. Has ambitions to set up a care agency but wants to be able to deliver care in a more personalised way. Hearing conversations from people she currently works with is helping to shape her offer.
- Sandra: Is moving from HR into setting up a CME to offer personal care.
 She wants something more suited to having a young child, which requires flexibility.



Emerging and developing enterprises

- Carolyn & Kathy: Been running cleaning businesses, which they now want to diversify into wider home help support, including a decluttering service in Lowestoft
- Gugu: Employed at Great Ormond Street with a clinical background, now wanting to work locally and flexibly, offering personal care and connections to community in Halesworth
- Anna: Professional background in finance, looking to establish a local enterprise that offers home help with a particular focus on teaching older people digital skills across East Suffolk
- Mary: Lots of experience working in care settings and trained in reflexology, now setting up an enterprise offering personal care in Southwold
