The application process:

- Receipt of on-line application
- Due diligence checks carried out by Grants Team have all the required supporting documents been submitted, does the applicant meet our "fit for funding" criteria?
- Application assessed by a Grants Officer is there enough detail, is there a full breakdown of the project budget, has the "need" been emphasised?
- Assessment sent to members of the Independent Funding Panel
- Funding Panel meeting held and decisions made
- Decisions sent to SCF trustees for ratification
- Successful applicants notified and if any outstanding conditions have been satisfied, grant is paid
- Unsuccessful applications moved to other funds where deemed appropriate





What do the Panel members look for?

Applications that:

- Meet the fund's criteria e.g. projects for the elderly
- Meet a pressing social need in the community/area of interest e.g. reducing social isolation
- Do not duplicate services already on offer in the area
- Are good value for money
- Are for innovative projects/new ideas
- Are for sustainable projects/organisations
- Are from organisations with a proven track record
