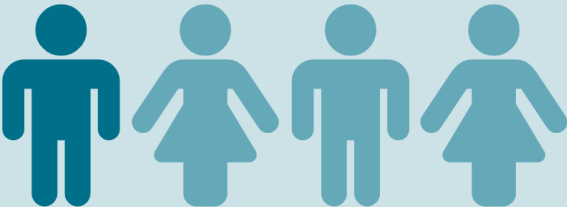

Age breakdown

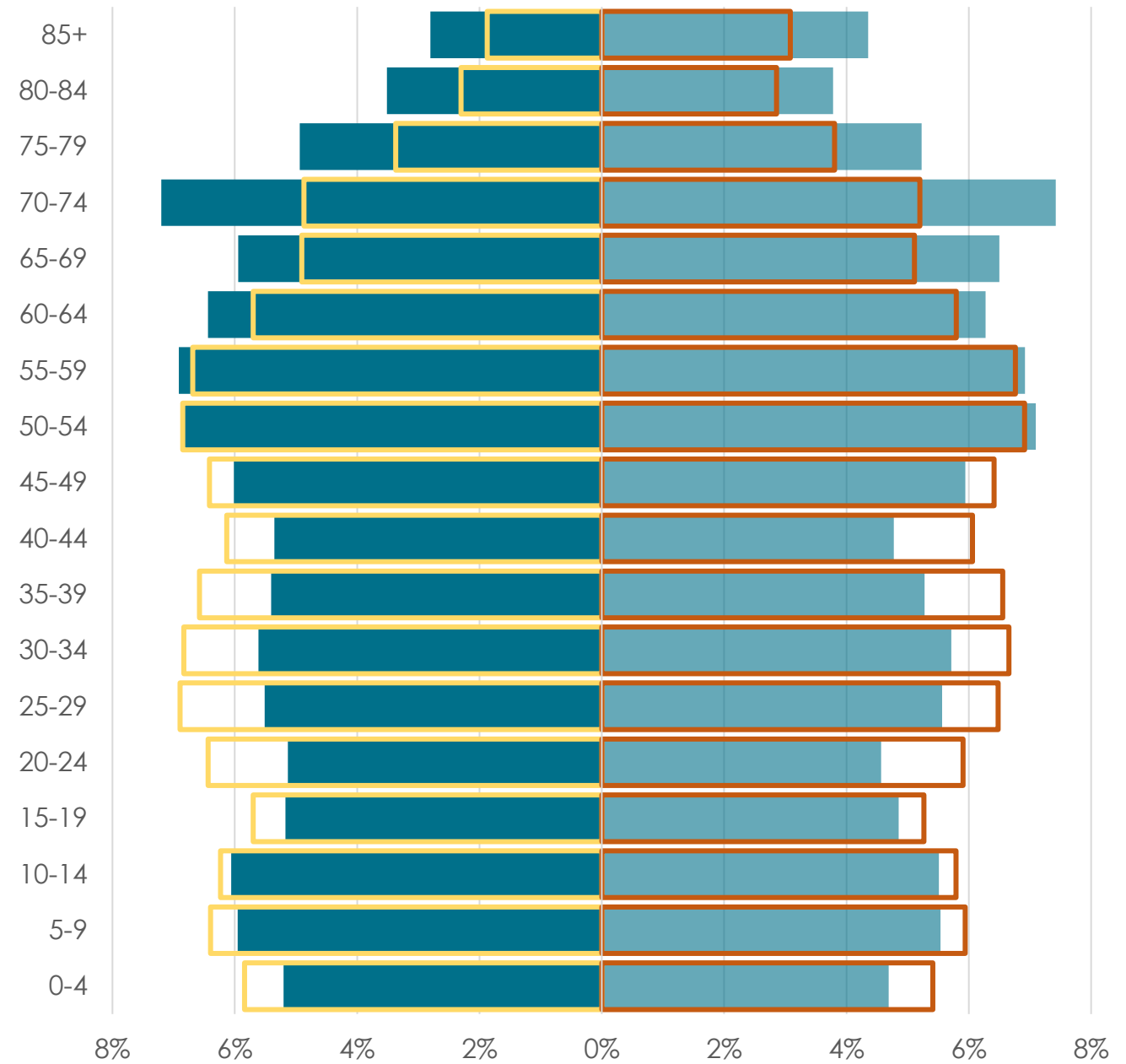
The age pyramid shows the age breakdown of the population of Lowestoft against the national average

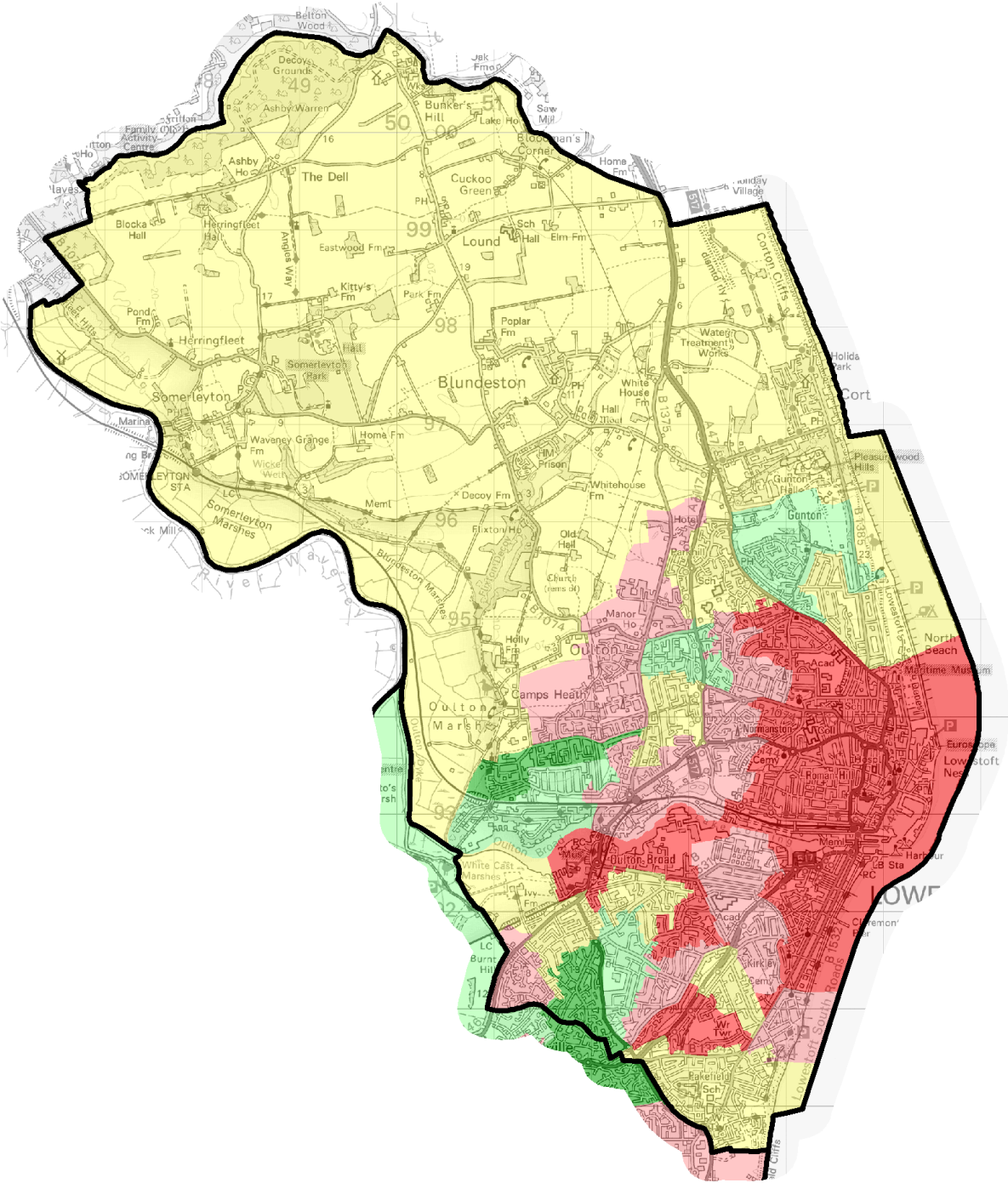

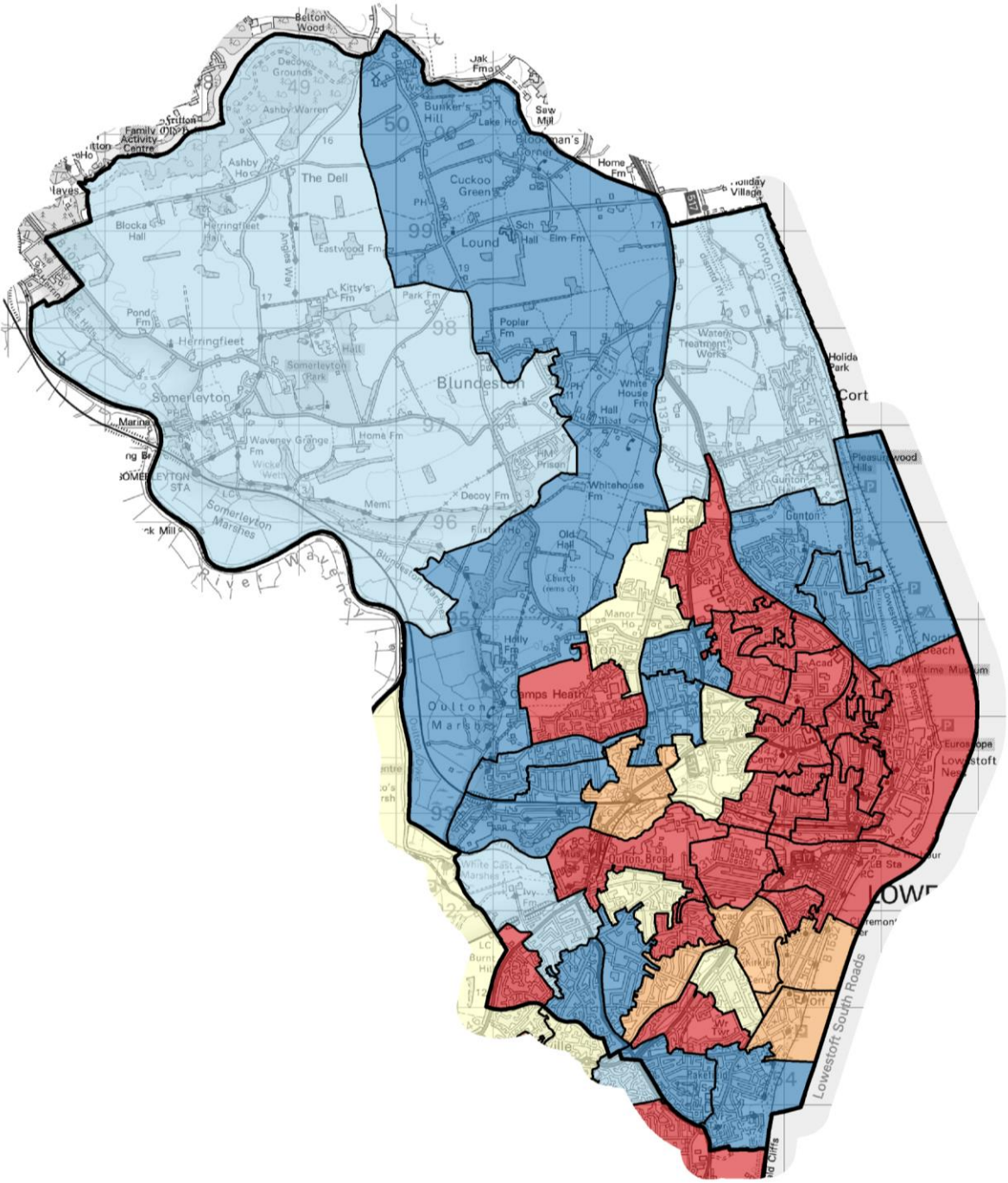

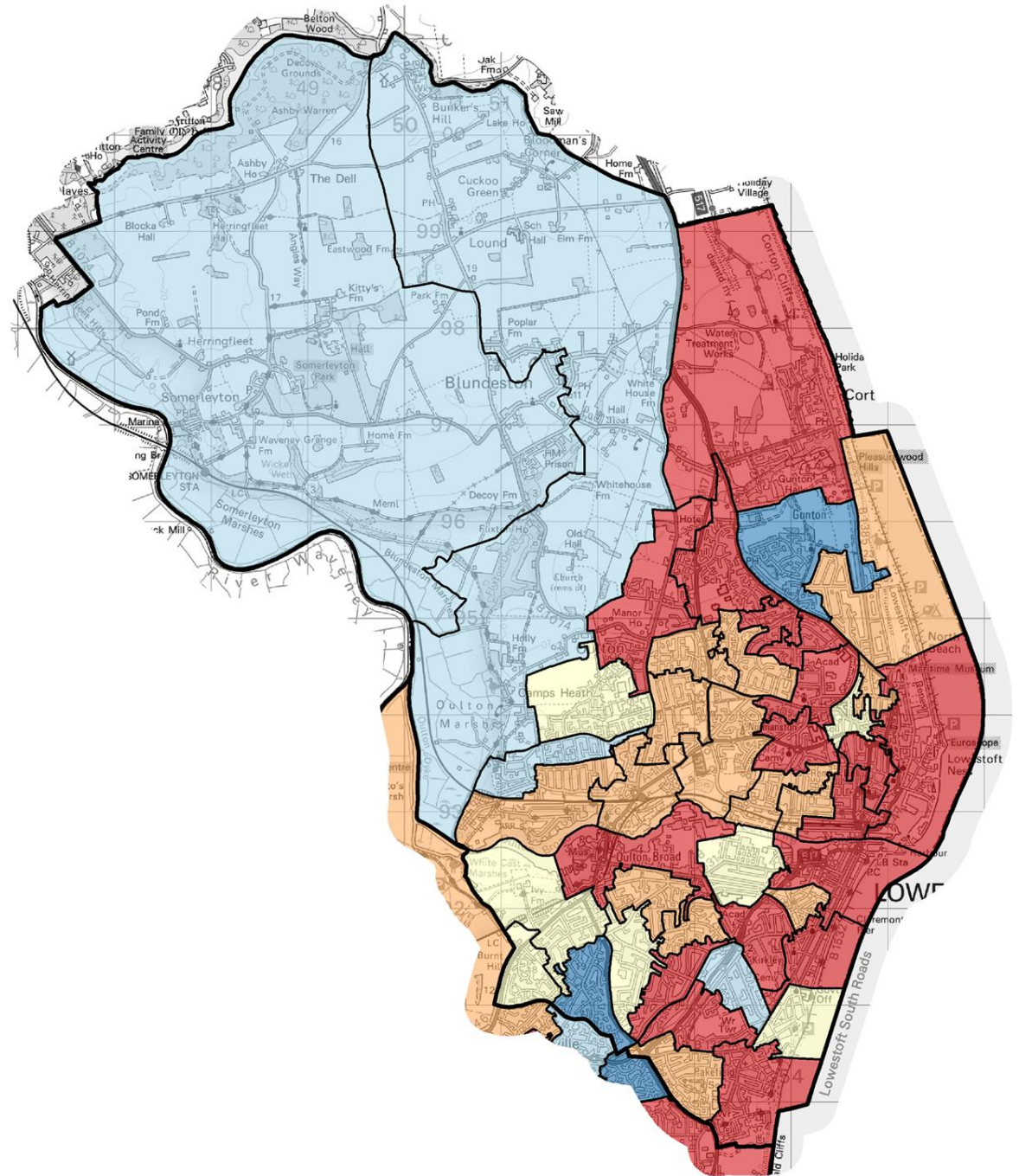
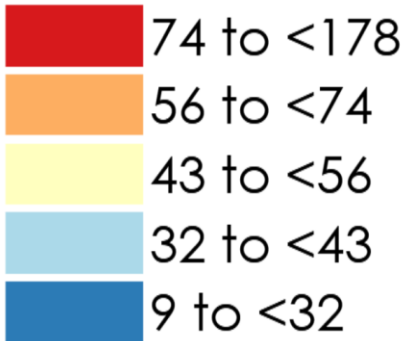
Children aged 0-15 income deprived

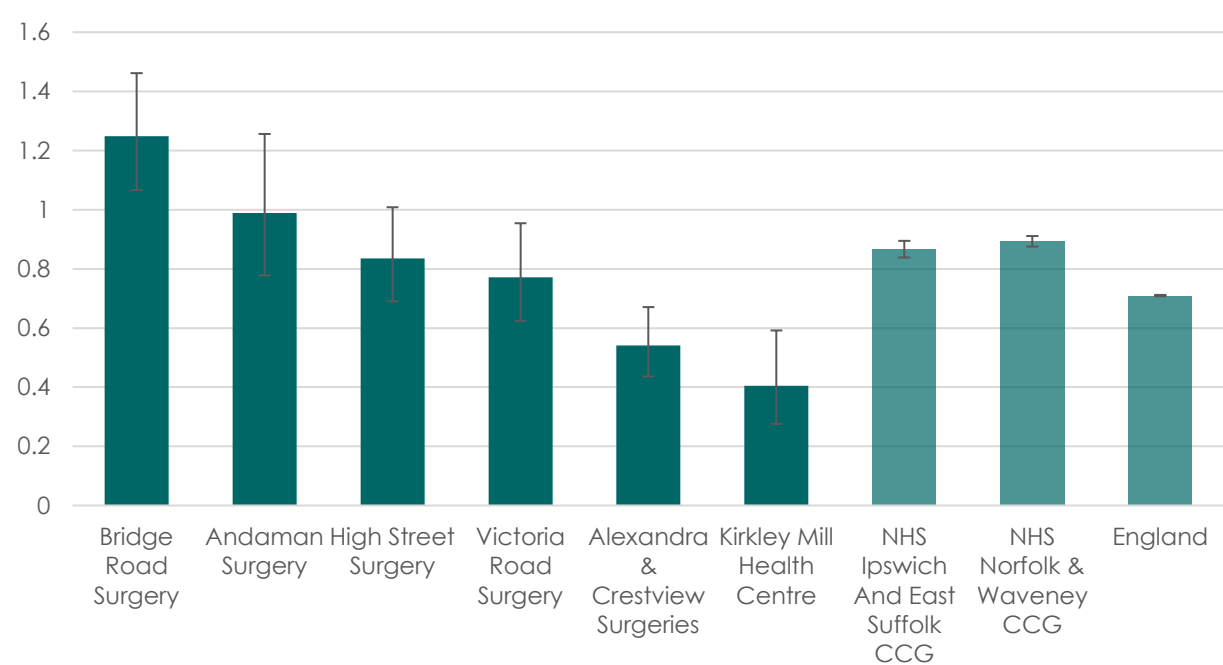

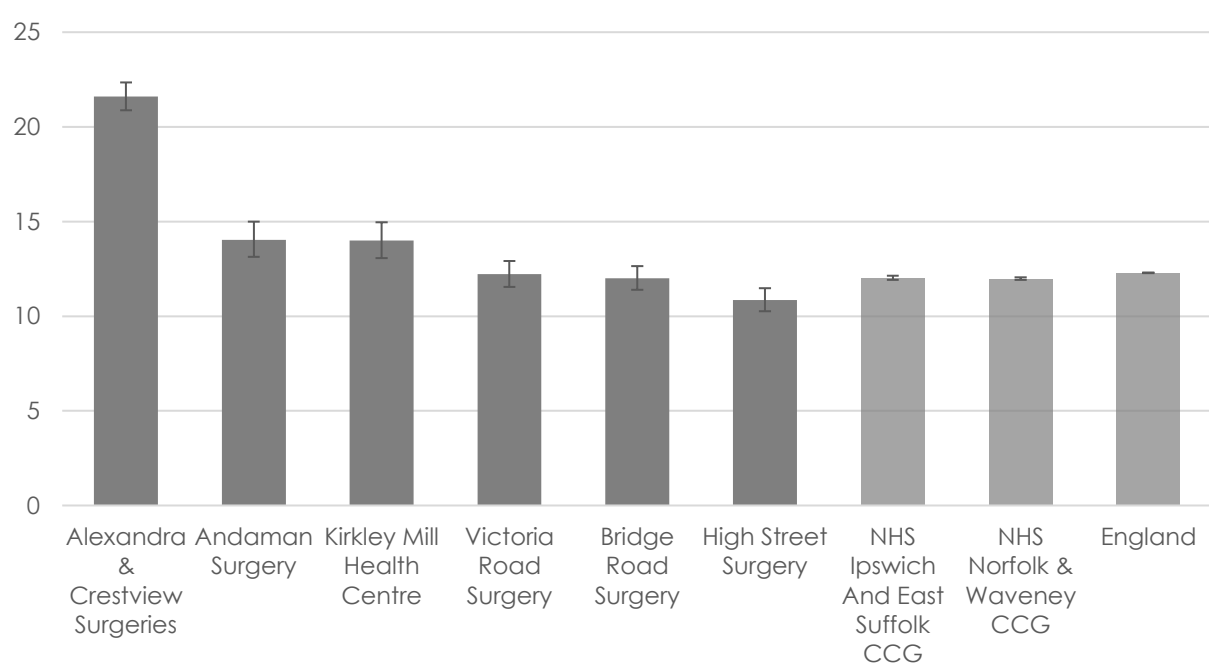

Prevalence of depression is higher than the national average among patients at Alexandra & Crestview Surgeries, Andaman Surgery and Kirkley Mill Health Centre

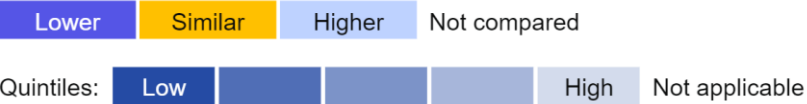

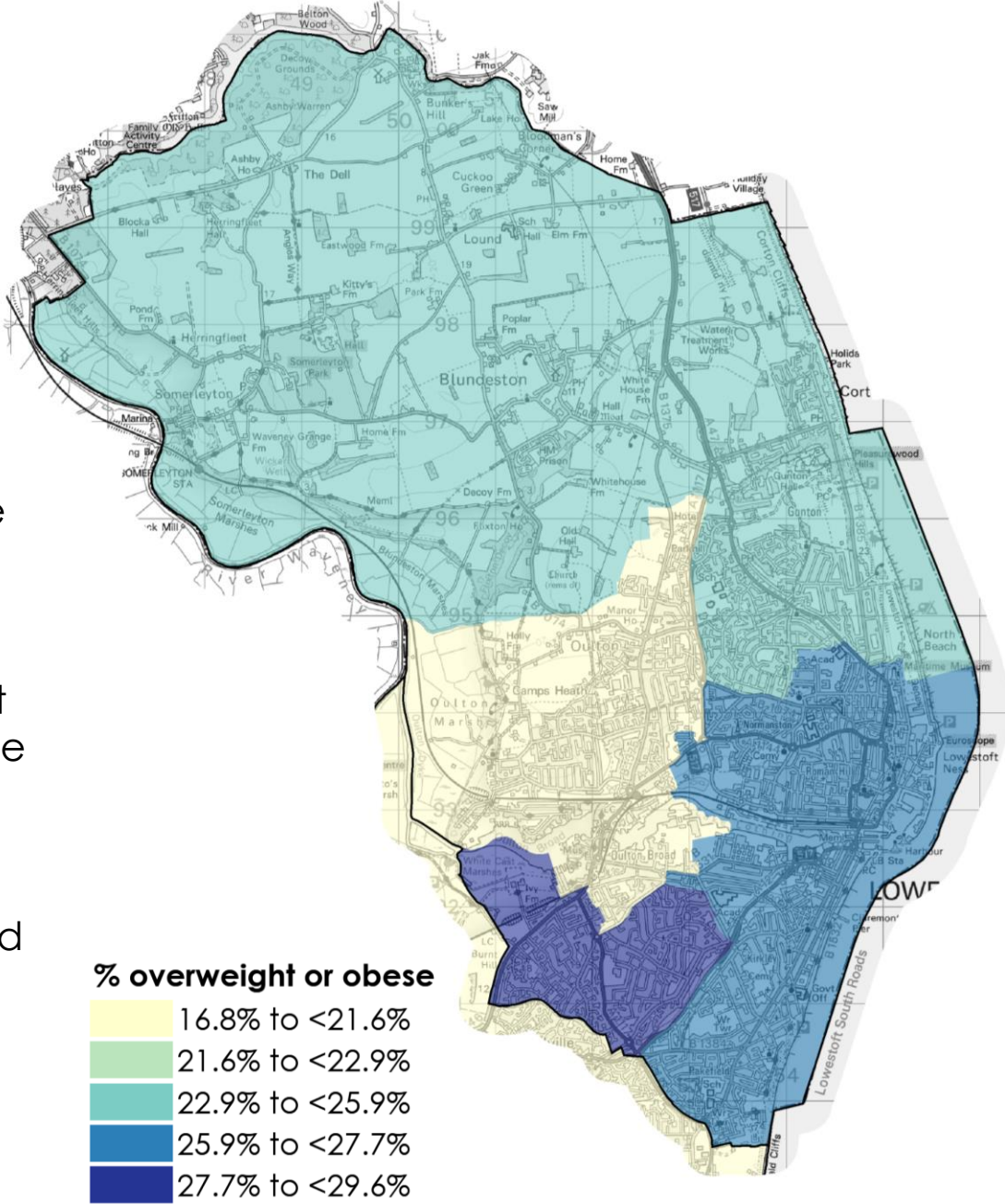

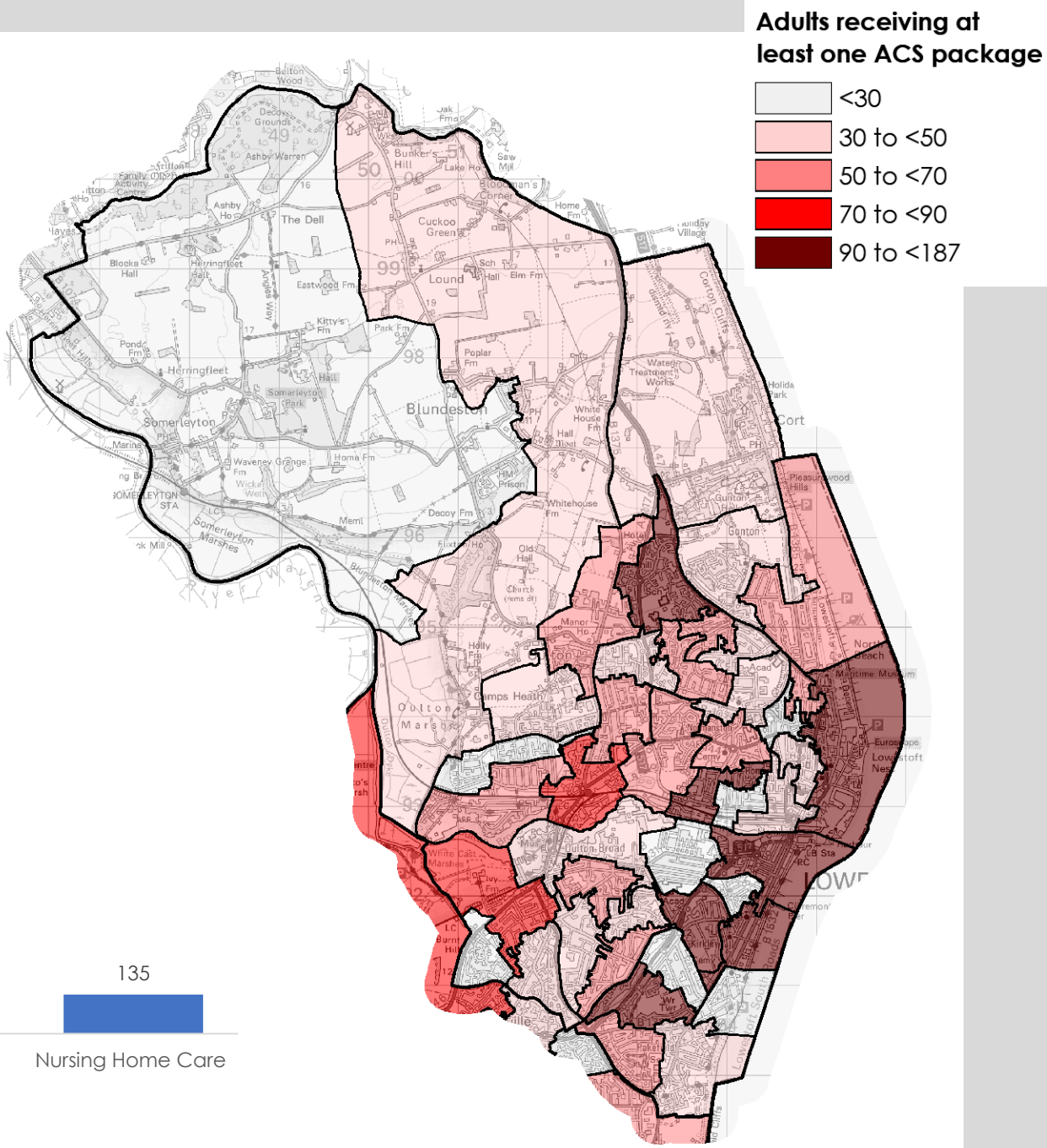

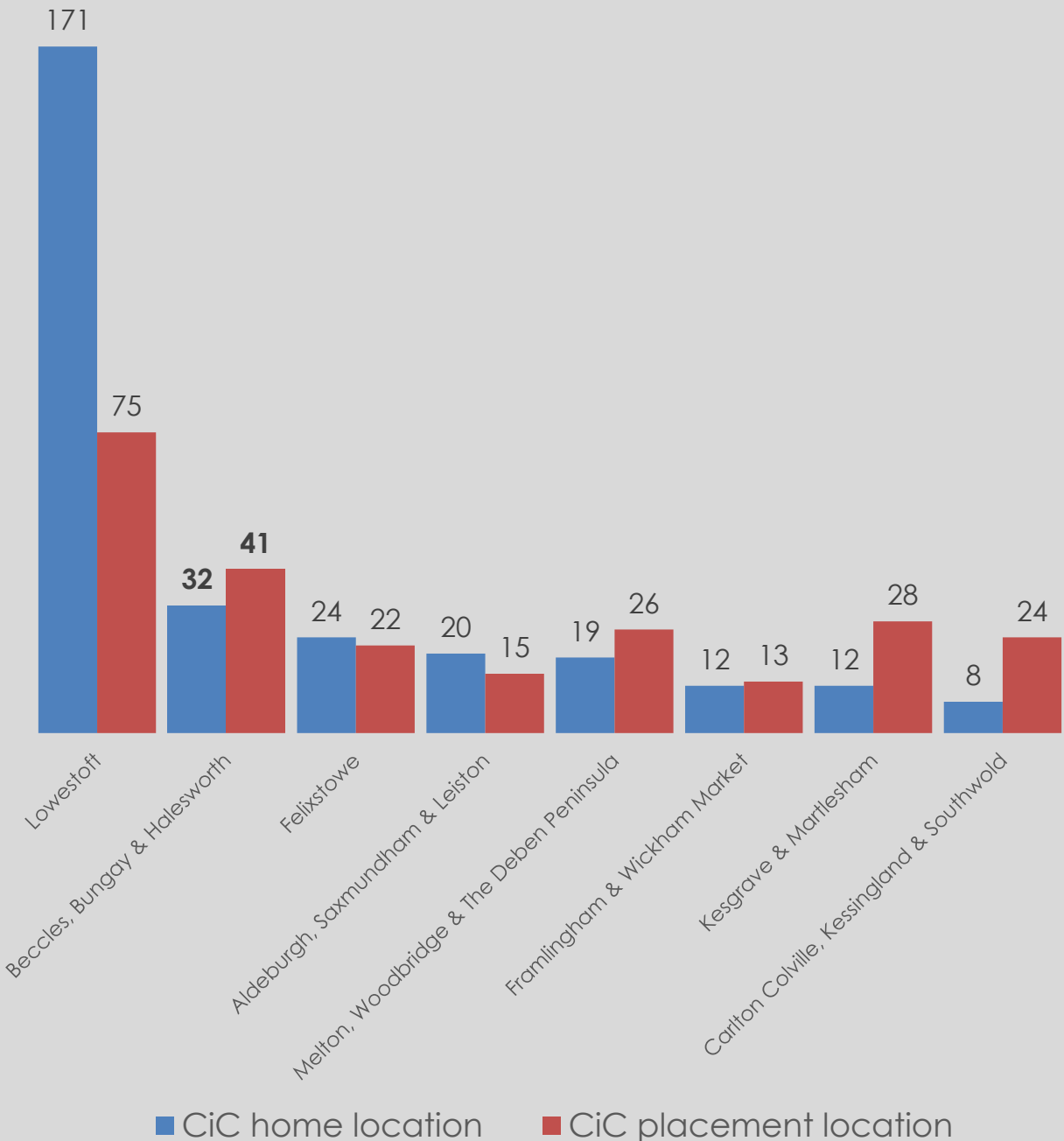

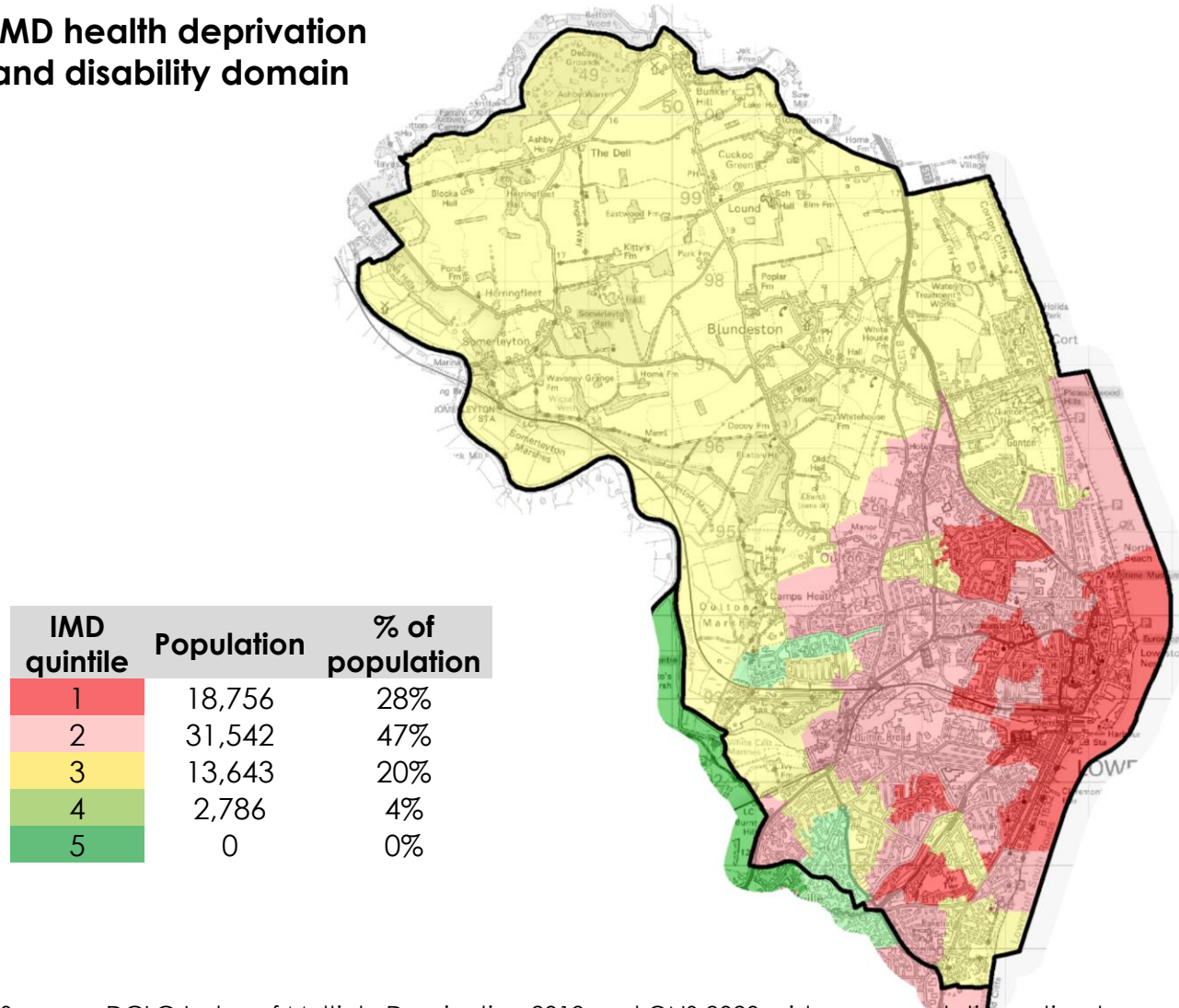

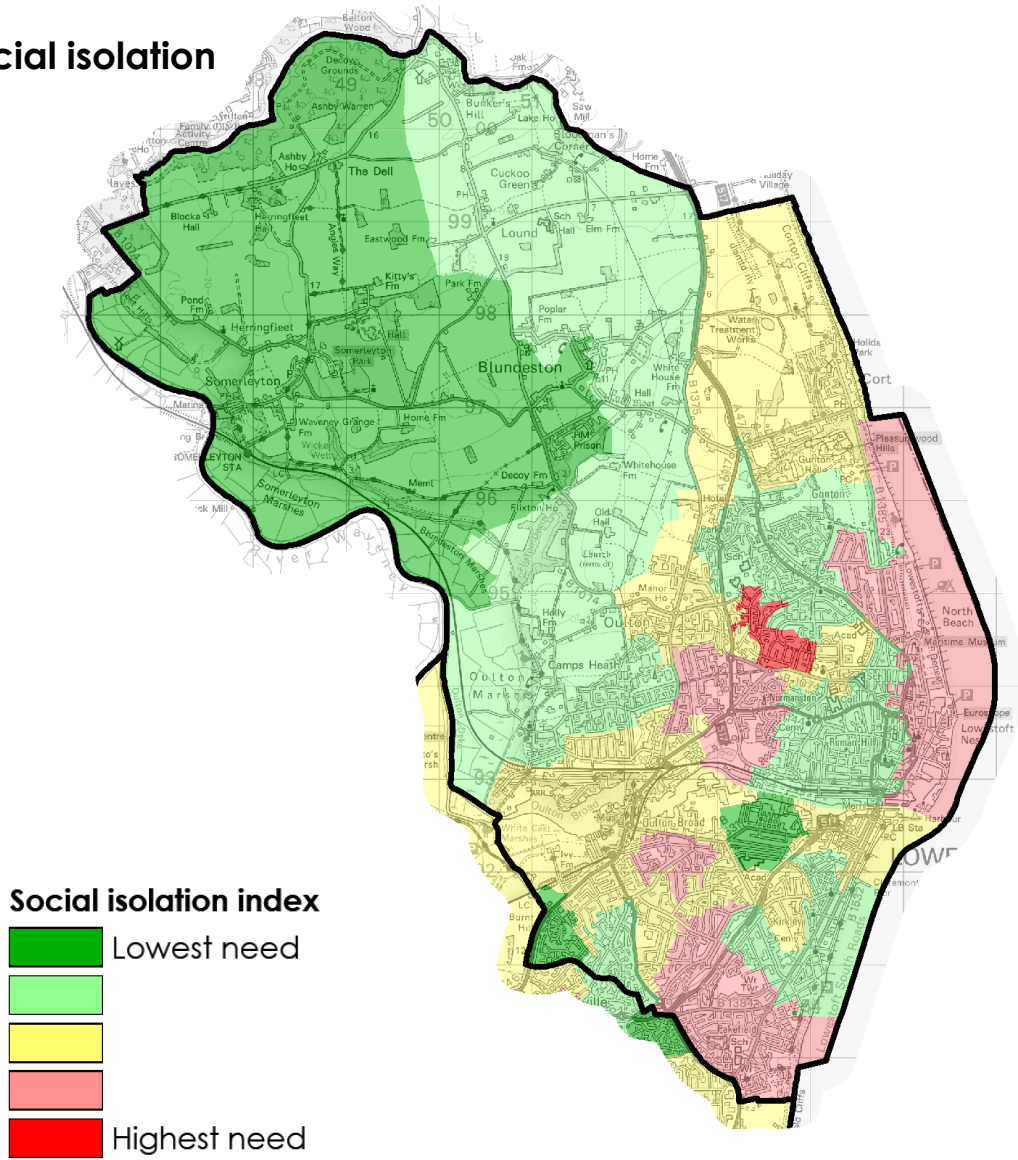

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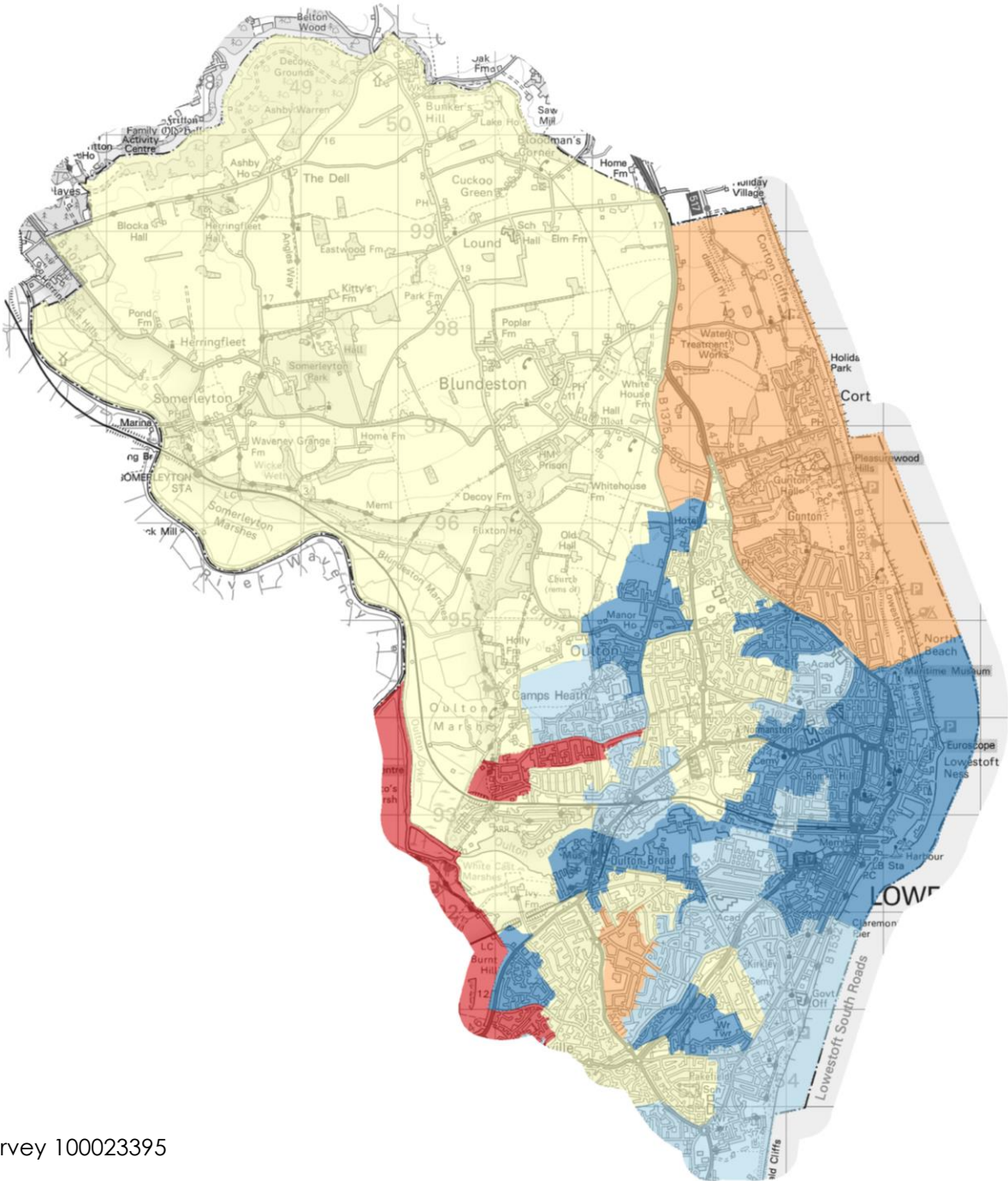

- Lowest levels of loneliness (bottom 20%)

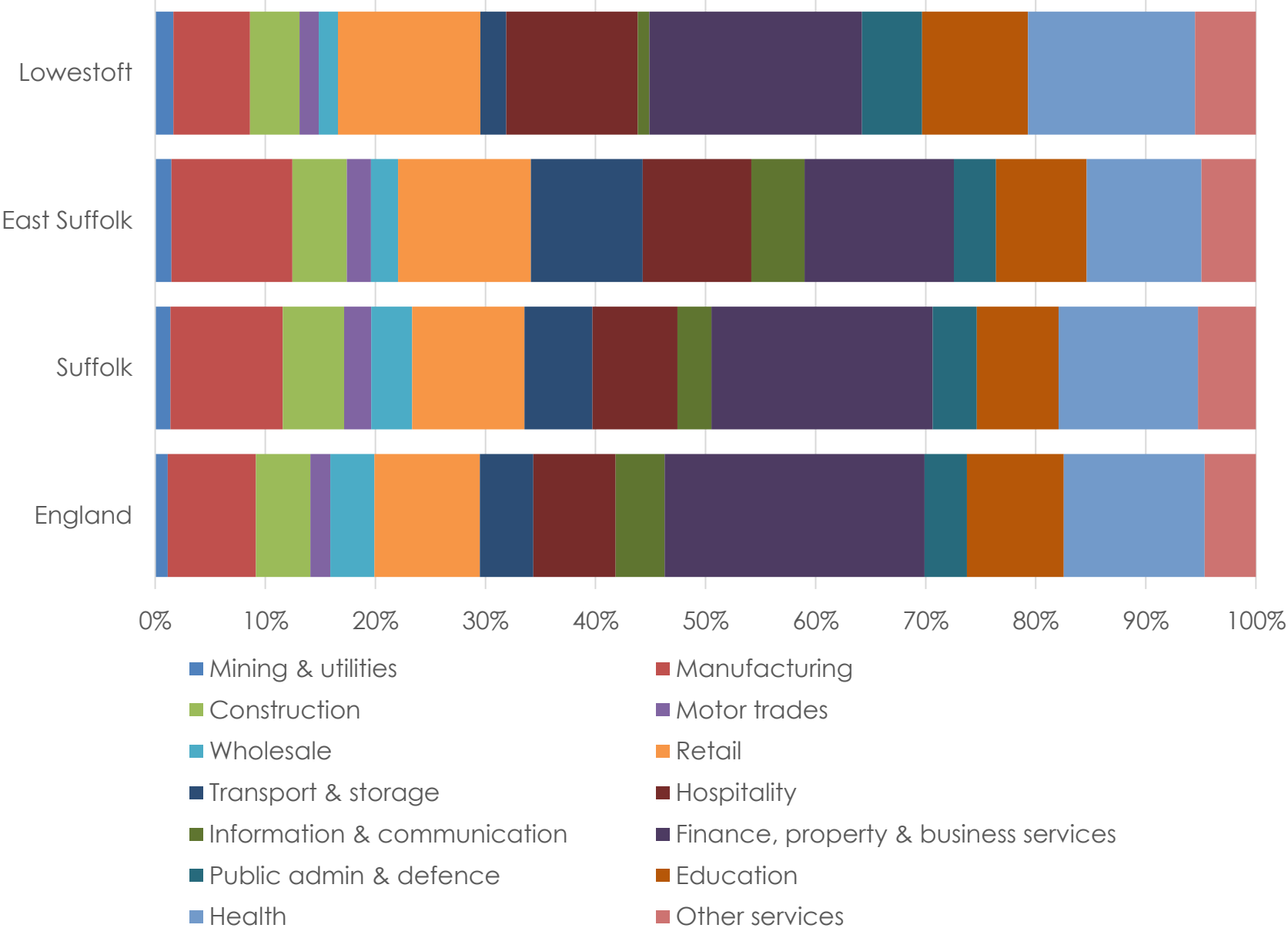

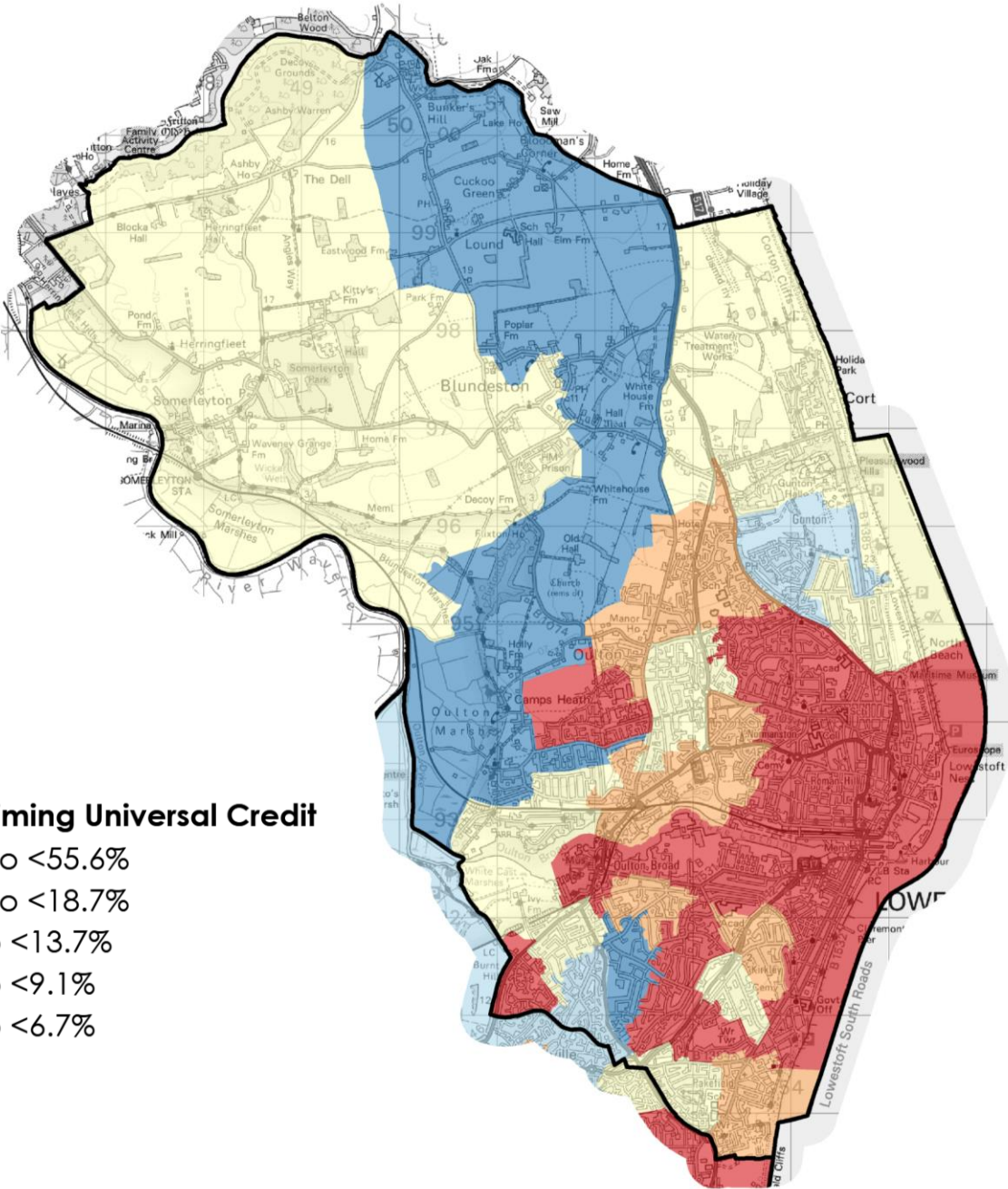

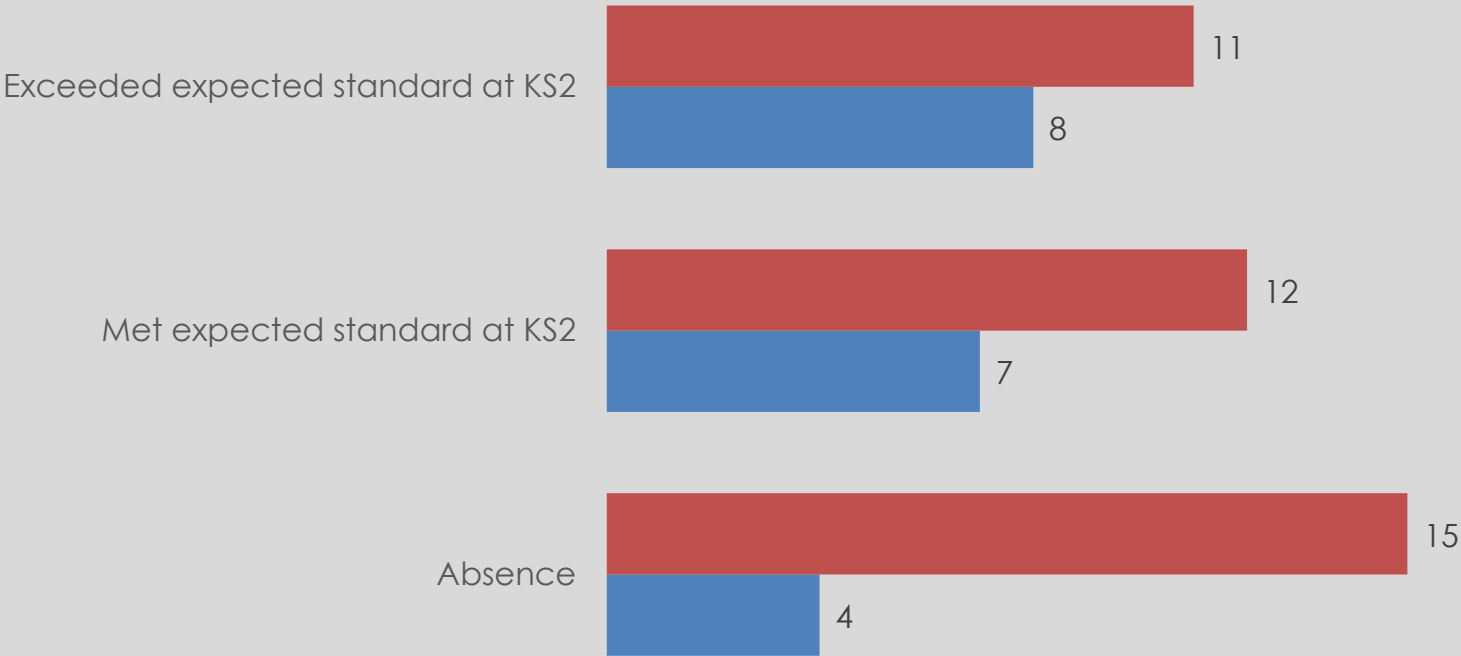

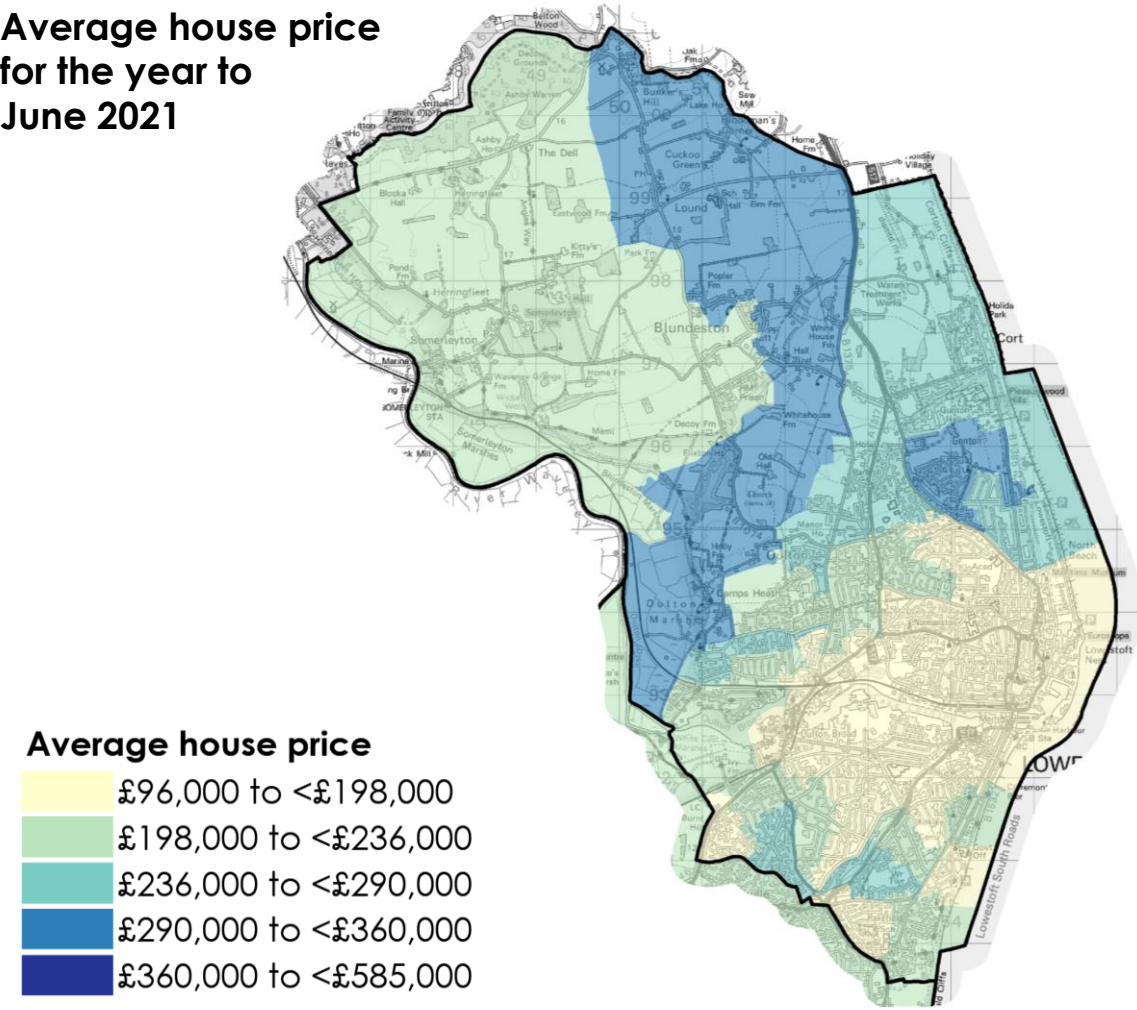

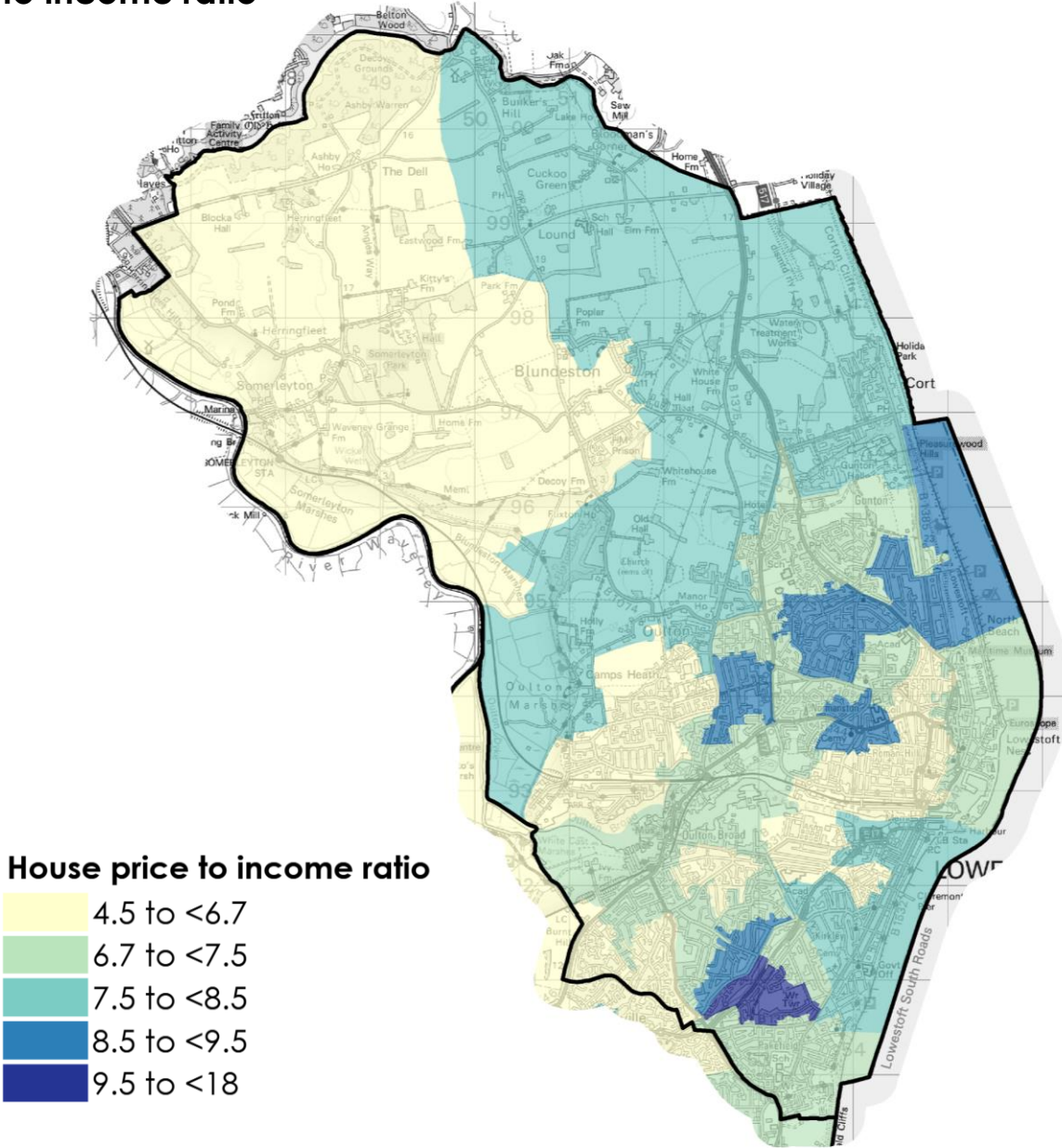

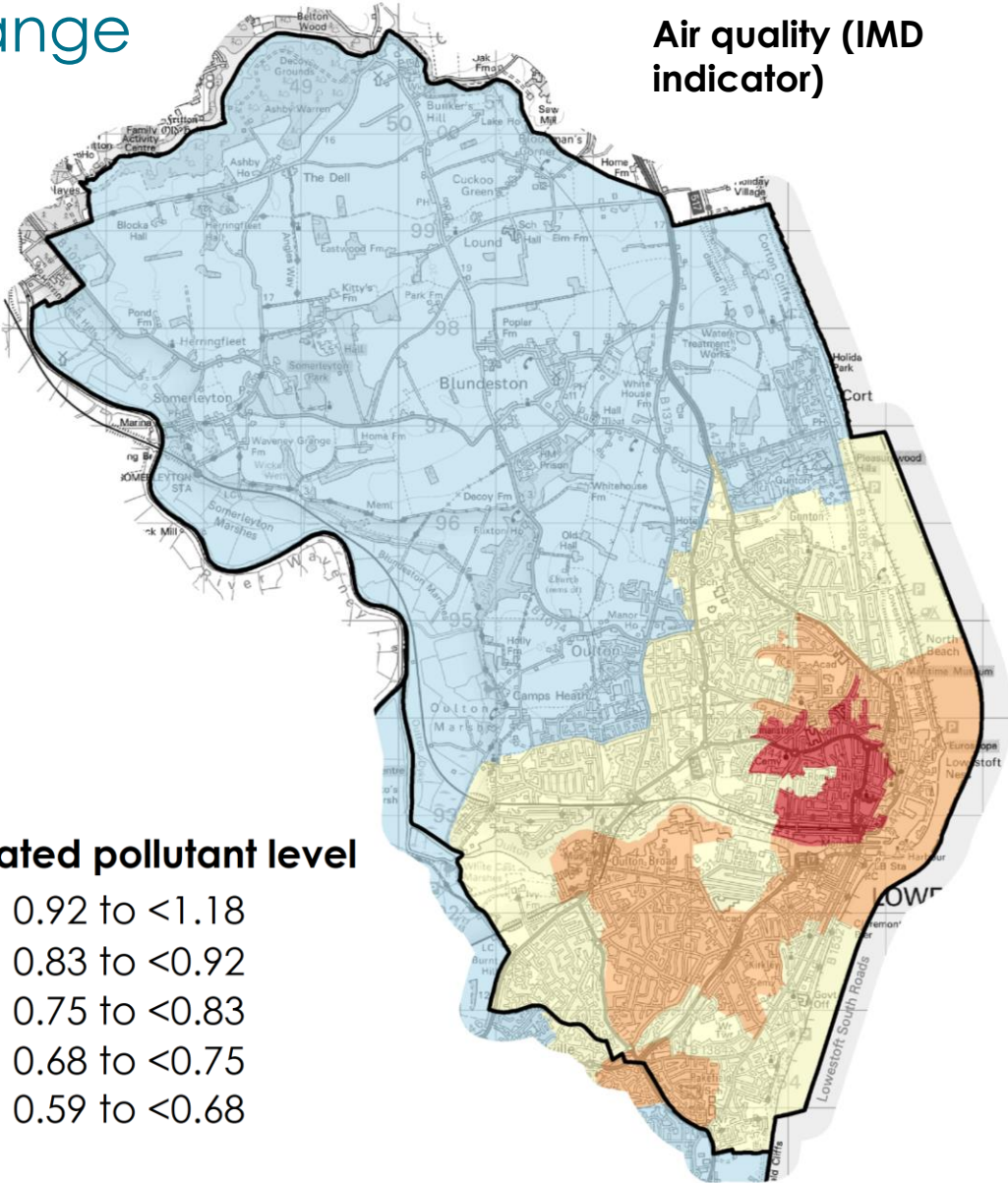

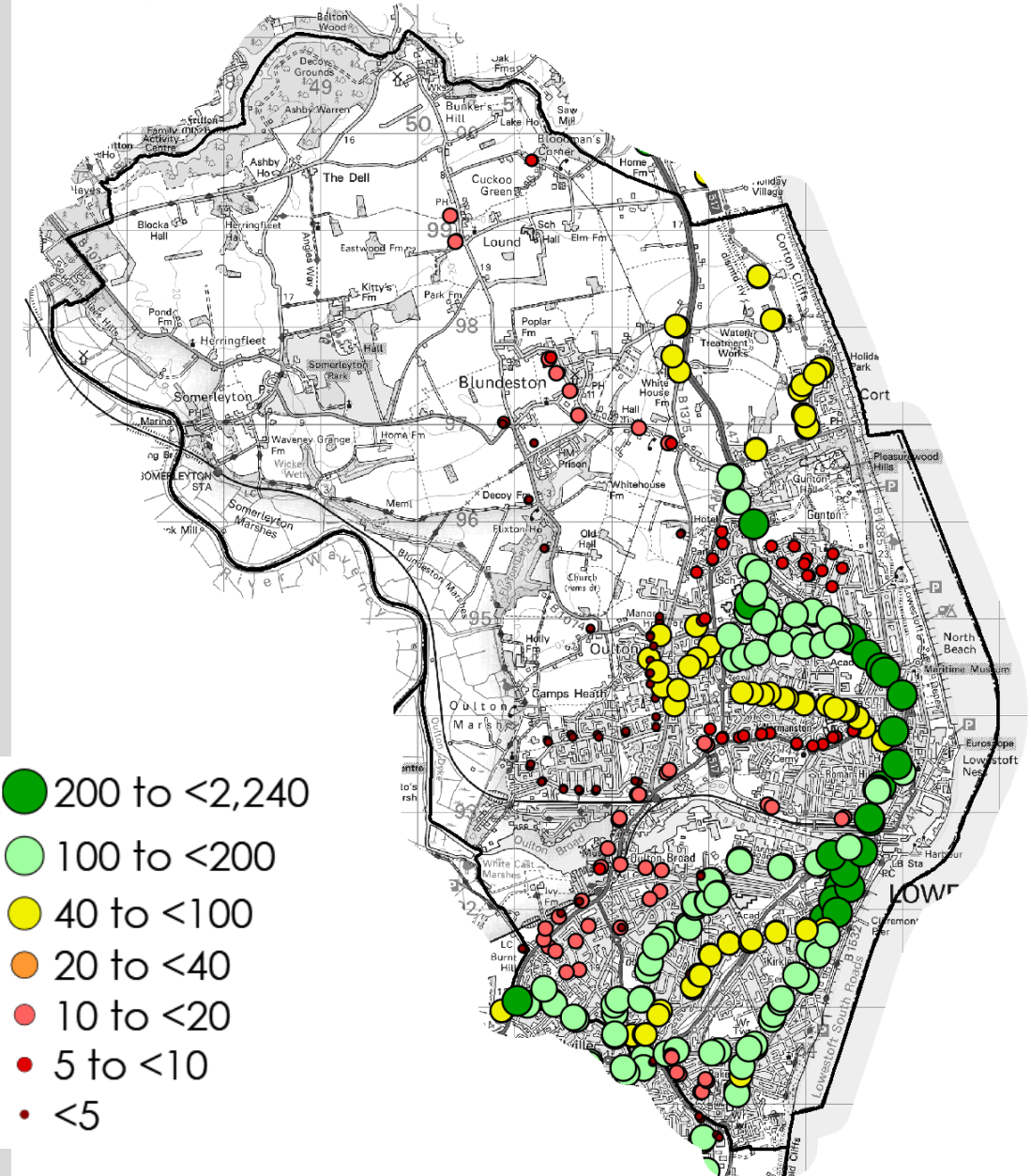
