5. Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm** on **Wednesday, 5 June 2024**.
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm** on **Thursday, 13 June 2024**.
