

VERIFICATION / COUNT ASSISTANT

JOB DESCRIPTION

Verification / Count Assistant (Casual Election Staff)

The Role

To work as part of a team following the instructions of the Verification or Count Supervisor in sorting and counting ballot papers quickly but accurately, whilst under pressure and under observation of candidates and agents. The role will be required to work at a Count Venue as assigned by the Returning Officer.

Duties and responsibilities

You will:

- arrive on time and be seated ready for a short training session from your table supervisor
- work in a team as chosen by the Returning Officer and Electoral Services Team
- verify and count the number of ballot papers in a ballot box against the verification totals and recount if required
- alert the Count Supervisor of any doubtful ballot papers as instructed
- tidy up and make good the count table at the end of the count
- remain politically neutral and always keep the secrecy of the ballot

As well as the duties listed, you may be asked to take on other tasks appropriate with your pay level.

Essential	 You must: have good communication skills and the ability to follow instructions have good administration skills and attention to detail be punctual, reliable and calm under pressure (candidates and agents are able to scrutinise the process you undertake) be a team player and have a flexible attitude able to travel to the Count Venue as required
Desirable	Previous experience as a Verification / Count Assistant

The Returning Officer is not permitted to employ anyone who is/or has carried out duties on behalf of any political party or candidate at the election.
