

Lowestoft Repairs and Maintenance

Lowestoft, Suffolk

What are we updating you about?

East Suffolk Council's (ESC) Coastal Management Team have appointed the Water Management Alliance (WMA) to complete repairs and maintenance of coastal protection assets along the Suffolk coast, which are owned or managed by ESC. WMA will be completing works at Lowestoft as part of that contract.

Where is this work happening?

A map of where the work is taking place is on page 2 of this factsheet. The work is spread across the defences from Links Road to Hamilton Road and South Pier to the All Saints Road area. There will be a temporary site compound on the beach adjacent to All Saints Road access ramp. There will be a digger operating on the beach.

When are we doing the work?

Repair and maintenance work along the coastal defences is due to take place from Monday 28th April 2025 to Friday 2nd May 2025, allowing our maintenance contractor to maximise work around daily tides. All work is subject to safe working conditions i.e. tide and weather condition dependant.

What will we be doing?

WMA will be removing hazards from groynes and replacing signage from the All Saints Road area to South Pier. We will also be clearing vegetation from the seawall between Hamilton Road and Links Road. We will work hard to keep any inconvenience to a minimum and ask the public to please take note of the contractor's signage when work is happening.

Why are we doing this work?

This work will improve public safety. The work is an important part of ESC's commitment to ensure their coastal assets are working effectively, helping to protect our beautiful coast economically, environmentally, and for the enjoyment of communities and visitors for generations to come.

Undertaking regular targeted maintenance means that we can maximise the lifespan of coastal protection assets, ensuring that we make the most of every pound spent and achieve a better return on public investment. We are supporting the safeguarding of life and local economies by making sure that the Council's coastal assets are in the condition needed for continued protection.

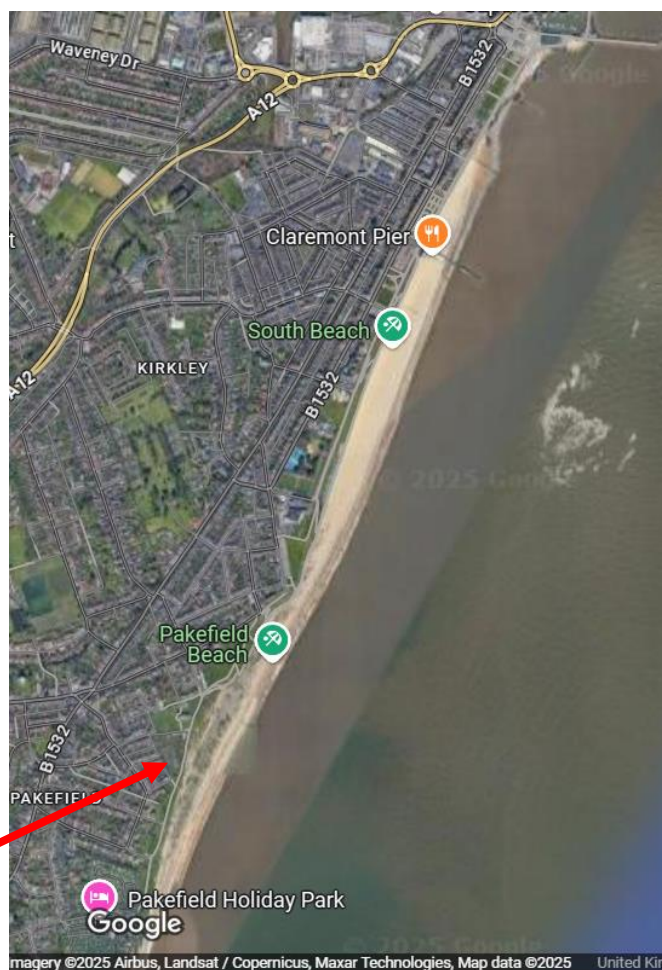
