We have found that people want the following:

- Bicycles—working and non working fine
- Books— a little tatty fine; damp/ripped/unreadable no thanks
- Clothes—washed and pressed and ready to wear only please
- CDs and DVDs—working ones only please—or let us know they don't work and we will promote as bird scarers
- Electrical items—working or repairable ones (the Benjamin Foundation are PAT testing them for us)
- Furniture—Bring along any furniture in good condition and, if upholstered, with a fire label still attached. Local charity Ipswich Furniture Project can also collect larger items from your home for free, if they are in good condition.
- Games—only ones with all the pieces please
- Garden tools, seeds, plant pots, native/veggie plant
- Kitchen items: crockery, bakeware, saucepans, knives and forks etc.
- Puzzles—only ones with all the pieces please
- Toys— only washed ones you would want your children to play with

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

The event is for materials from households, not businesses. If your items can fit in a family car and you think someone may be able to use them, then we can take them. We cannot accept paint.

As this event is to help individuals in need and the Benjamin Foundation and not to provide goods for private resale: a limited number of items can be taken away per person. Ideally you will bring an item to exchange for one you want—but this is not essential as the purpose is to share the reuse rather than buy new and give rather than throw away message.
