Visited by millions of birds annually, [RSPB Minsmere](#) is a key part of the extensive network of coastal wetlands along the east coast that have collectively been nominated for UNESCO status as a Natural World Heritage site, as the English East Coast Wetlands, which in turn form part of the East Atlantic Flyway, for their global significance for migratory wetlands birds travelling between the Arctic and southern Africa.

The RSPB have invited us to visit to show us around the diverse habitats forming this reserve of some 1000 hectares, learn about its biodiversity, the importance of the reserve in the context of the wider East Atlantic Flyway, and what the UNESCO bid for the East Coast Wetlands might mean.
