Communities in east Suffolk are currently hosting a concentration of new Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIPs), including Sizewell C, that seek to contribute to the supply and distribution of the increased levels of energy demanded by our society.

We have arranged a guided afternoon tour of <u>Wild Aldhurst</u>, a wildlife habitat creation scheme led by Sizewell C, at a former onion farm near the power station. This visit has been arranged for us to see how impacts on local biodiversity are being mitigated and how the target of 19% net gain to biodiversity will be achieved.
