

Visit to iFarm combined with Community Climate Action workshop

Guided tour and workshop organised on behalf of the Greenprint Forum

iFarm is a volunteer-led Community Benefit Society (CBS), operating in six parishes on the borders of Norfolk and Suffolk. Its purpose is to combat loneliness and social isolation. Membership is locally rooted; volunteers with a vision for rural regeneration, led by a restorative approach to agricultural and horticultural business, scientific, educational and cultural activities.

All are welcome to attend iFarm's <u>Visitor & Open Day</u>, to discover what iFarm have been doing and their plans for the future. iFarm will be showcasing their <u>Community Climate Action</u> (CCA) planning; the outcomes, plan and activities to ensure a thriving environment for their community, and the work of the <u>Climate Emergency Centre</u> around our region.

Tours of the land will run, with the site manager and head gardener showing you what has been achieved this year and outling plans for the future, including water management: irrigation, rain water harvesting and filtration.

Members of the Greenprint Forum are also invited to participate in a **short workshop from 12:00-13:00** to apply the Community Climate Action approach to their area.

The workshop condenses what would normally be 16hrs of workshops into just a single hour of fast paced, interactive activity; from which participants take away a top-level strategic plan for their area. You can watch a <u>short video</u> short video on the workshop delivery.

This is, in essence, a taster workshop for what can be delivered in attendees' areas to write (and then enact) their own Community Climate Action plan.
