Following a discussion with us the organisers of this event went out of their way to try to make it as low plastic and plastic action engaging as possible. Given this was the first time they had tried to do this they did very well with good signage, art engagement activities and plastic made from plants.

## **Key questions:**

- 1) Should I feed a hedgehog that is in my garden? I feed hedgehogs using specialist hedgehog food however meat based cat food is also fine. The most critical things are: a shallow bowl of water (never milk), ensuring it can get in and out of gardens easily and that no poisons or hazards like open drains or netting are present.
- 2) What can I recycle: confusion over aerosols, plastics and items marked as compostable.
- 3) What compost bins work best? Is it ok to use newspaper and should we layer or scrunch? Can we compost bracken? Is urine effective?
- 4) Is any of it really recycled if so where and what is it turned into
