I support the creation of the footpath.

I believe the creation of the footpath to link Blythvale to Holton should proceed on the following grounds.

1. It will create a safer route for children who attend school at Holton primary school.
2. It will create a safer route for elderly people to access Holton village hall for many of the activities that are held there and to access Holton Garden centre safer.
3. It makes common sense to proceed with the creation of the footpath to link Blythvale to Holton as it was built by Hopkins Homes as part of their housing development , however all necessary safety barriers / gates/ warning signs need to be put in place before the footpath is opened. If any house owners adjacent to the footpath have been disadvantaged, the council and/ or Hopkins Homes should review the impact the footpath has created on them and if significant they should be adequately compensated.
4. Warning signs stating motorised vehicles are prohibited to use the footpath.
5. Warning signs stating dog owners are required to pick up and bag all dog poo their dog has deposited on the footpath.
