Since our last newsletter, Kier has progressed works across all areas of the site. All main building structures are now completed and are watertight, which has released the internal fitting out works.

Internal fitting out works continue to progress across all areas of the site. Kitchens and bathrooms have started to be installed into the houses.

Following on-going removal of the external scaffolding as building envelopes have progressed, services, external works and landscaping have commenced.
