Garrison Lane Road Closure Update

Following our last update, we thank all local residents for your patience and understanding during the road closure period since 10 June.

The planned utilities and services connections have progressed well during the closure period. All mains services required for the development now connected into the utilities system and available at the development entrance on Garrison Lane.

The construction of the new manhole and connection to the Anglian Water drainage network has also commenced during the past three weeks. Our dedicated civil engineering team working on this element have experienced some construction challenges during the past three weeks, primarily as a result of having to deal with and remove vast quantities of groundwater from the excavation, in order to safely construct the required apparatus.

Unfortunately, this has slowed our planned progress on this particular operation.

We have now been granted a one-week extension to the road closure period by Suffolk Highways, to ensure Garrison Lane road construction and markings are safely re-instated prior to the route being fully re-opened to traffic.

The closure will now continue until the end of the day on Monday 8 July 2024, 24 hours per day, seven days per week. Working hours on these operations however will continue to be Monday to Friday 7:30am to 6.00pm and Saturday from 7:30am to 1.00pm. We thank you for your continued patience and understanding during this closure period.

The diversion route shall continue to be fully signed, and is via A1021 Grove Road, Beatrice Avenue and Orwell Road to the east of Garrison Lane.

Pedestrian access continues to be maintained on the opposite footway to location of the works and Kier gate staff will be in attendance to ensure homeowners' access requirements within the closure area are maintained.
