# Garrison Lane Road Closure

A temporary, three-week closure to a section of Garrison Lane in Felixstowe will be applied by Kier Construction, on behalf of East Suffolk Council, enabling essential infrastructure work for the Deben Fields development.

This road closure, approved by Suffolk Highways, will temporarily prevent through traffic on the section of Garrison Lane between Cobbold Road and Princes Gardens. It will facilitate all main services and infrastructure connections to the new development within a single closure period:

- Water
- Electricity
- Communications
- Foul drainage connection to the Anglian Water network

The diversion route shall be fully signed, and is via A1021 Grove Road, Beatrice Avenue and Orwell Road to the east of Garrison Lane

Full information, informing the public of this closure, will shortly be displayed in this location, and this includes closure signage and advance warning boards.

The closure will be between Monday 10 June and Monday 1 July 2024, 24 hours per day, seven days per week. Working hours however will be Monday to Friday 7:30am to 6pm and Saturday from 7:30am to 1pm.

All services are being procured and managed directly by Kier Construction with a dedicated Kier manager overseeing road closure and services works. Traffic management staff will also be in attendance throughout.

Meanwhile, pedestrian access will be maintained on the opposite footway to location of the works and Kier gate staff will be in attendance to ensure homeowners' access requirements within the closure area are maintained.
