On **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September** East Suffolk welcomes the **Stage 1 of the Lloyds Tour of Britain Men**. The 21<sup>st</sup> edition of the race will take place starting in Woodbridge and finishing in Southwold.

In order to ensure a safe route for the participants it is necessary to suspend on street parking between **11:00** and **15:00** on **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September** within **Framlingham**:

- **B1120 Badingham Rd (from 29 Badingham Rd to B1119)**
- **B110 Fore Street (from Castle St to Albert Place)**
- **B1116 College Rd (from record shop to Pembroke Road)**
- **Pembroke Road (from College Rd to Mount Pleasant)**

Please find enclosed a plan highlighting the area affected.

To minimise the inconvenience, we will endeavor to remove the cones as soon as practicably possible once the race has passed through.

Please ensure that your vehicles (and any vehicles belonging to visitors you may have) are removed from these areas before the restrictions apply.

The cones will be installed the evening prior to the race and advance warning signage installed two weeks prior.
