

Dear Sir/Madam,

On **Sunday 8th September** East Suffolk welcomes the **Stage 6 of the Lloyds Bank Tour of Britain Men**. The 20th edition of the race will take place over 158 km (98.5 mile) starting in Lowestoft and finishing in Felixstowe.

In order to ensure a safe route for the participants, it will be necessary to suspend on street parking on the following roads within **Grundisburgh**:

- **Woodbridge Road/The Green/The Street/Rose Hill**
- **Ipswich Road (up to Post Mill Gardens)**

Please find enclosed a plan highlighting the area affected.

These restrictions will apply between **09:00** and **15:00** on **Sunday 8th September**, although to minimise the inconvenience, we will endeavour to remove the cones as soon as practicably possible once the race has passed through.

Please ensure that your vehicles (and any vehicles belonging to visitors you may have) are removed from these areas before the restrictions apply.

The cones will be installed the evening prior to the race and advance warning signage installed two weeks prior.
