Work to Deben starting soon

We're excited that works are on schedule to start at Deben Leisure Centre by our Leisure Development Partners, Pulse Fitness, next month.

We would like to thank members of Deben Leisure Centre for their support for the redevelopment so far.

Although the works mean that the facility will be fully closed during the building works, we think you will be pleased with the redeveloped Deben Leisure Centre when it reopens next summer.

During the closure you can use our other facilities at Leiston, Felixstowe and Brackenbury.

The works are scheduled to last for a 10 month period. Our Leisure operational partners

Places for People Leisure have communicated alternative options for the closure period to all their members and will continue to do so during the project.

The great news is that we are already planning the opening event for the new leisure centre next summer!

With works to Deben starting imminently, we now look to our next project at Leiston and are asking for your views on the revised plans.

Timeline of works

Deben Leisure Centre will close to the public at 10pm on Thursday, 31 August. Works will start from Monday, 4 September and will last for approximately 10 months.

Due to the nature of the work being undertaken, a full closure is required.

The refurbished leisure centre will reopen in summer 2018.

Please note there will be some loss of car parking spaces in Station Road Car Park during this time. The community hall and the businesses at Quay Point will not be affected by the redevelopment.

Staff at Deben Leisure Centre are employed by our operators, Places for People Leisure.

During the redevelopment, as many staff as possible have been relocated to our other leisure centres.

The leisure centre is expected to reopen in summer 2018.



The new facility will create more job opportunities, with people being recruited 2-3 months prior to opening.

Why did you join?


I have always enjoyed swimming and it is a good way of keeping fit.

The new facilities, including the showers and changing rooms.


I'm looking forward to the new leisure centre offering facilities to the people of Woodbridge of all ages.
