I am writing to you as you were previously invited to make comments on the Waveney Community Infrastructure Levy Draft Charging Schedule in October 2012. The Draft Charging Schedule has now been submitted for independent examination and the Examiner appointed is inviting comments on some new information provided by the Council.

As you may be aware, Waveney District Council submitted its Community Infrastructure Levy draft Charging Schedule for examination on the 14th December 2012.

The purpose of the Community Infrastructure Levy is to raise money to fund infrastructure to support new development. It will be payable by developers undertaking new building projects in an area.

New guidance relating to the Community Infrastructure Levy (http://www.gov.uk/government/uploads/system/uploads/attachment_da_ta/file/36743/Community_Infrastructure_Levy_guidance_Final.pdf) was published by the Government on the same day that the Council submitted their draft charging schedule. This means that the Council has to follow this new guidance.

The new guidance requires that the Council provides a draft list of the projects or types of infrastructure that may be funded in part or wholly by the Community Infrastructure Levy, i.e. will not be funded through Section 106 planning obligations in the future. The guidance also requires that the Council provides information on the relationship between planning obligations (section 106 agreements or undertakings) and the Community Infrastructure Levy.
