





CIL investment in communities

- To date we have distributed over £7 million in Neighbourhood CIL
- Lots of examples of collaborative spend through NCIL, DCIL and LCIL Funds together with other funding streams, donations, etc
- Total District CIL spend/allocation to date of nearly £16 million
- Ringfencing of £13 million of remaining District CIL to secure Health and Education projects proposed to be delivered in the 5-year period.
- A recent **Local CIL 3% Fund** great for smaller local projects ready to be built.
- A new 3% Local CIL Play Fund introduced this year.
- Forward funding of up to £1million of Neighbourhood CIL now possible.
- We've developed a much stronger understanding of the actual cost of infrastructure.


