

Local Plans

- Suffolk Coastal Local Plan (adopted September 2020)
- Waveney Local Plan (adopted March 2019)
- 25 'Made' Neighbourhood Plans



Local Plans

- Focus on implementation of current plans
- Implementation includes preparation of Supplementary Planning Documents; monitoring (incl. Housing Action Plan).
- Waveney Local Plan Review Assessment (required prior to 5th anniversary of adoption) approved in March 2024 concluded that it isn't necessary to undertake a review of the Plan
- Housing Land Supply (annual update to be published shortly). Nov 2023 update:

Suffolk Coastal Local Plan area – 6.34 yrs

Waveney Local Plan area – 5.62 yrs




How many new homes have been built over the past five vears?

 4.047 new homes have been completed over the past five years in East Suffolk • 2,710 were completed in the former Suffolk Coastal area, and 1.337 in the former Waveney area.

This map shows where new homes were built between 1st April 2018 and 31st March 2023. A darker shade indicates a higher number of net completions. Move around the map and click on a Parish to find out more.

Plan-making reforms Levelling-Up and Regeneration Act 2023 – some key elements

- National Development Management Policies
- Supplementary Plans (no SPDs)
- Removes Duty to Co-operate
- Regard to Neighbourhood Priorities Statements

Previous Government consulted on detailed proposals on the plan-making process in Summer 2023, including

- 30 37 month timetable for plan preparation
- Gateway checks at points throughout preparation
- Digitisation
- Consultation and engagement a key part of the process

Plan-making reforms

New Government

- Intend to implement plan-making reforms as set out in the Levelling Up and Regeneration Act 2023, from Summer or Autumn 2025.
- Intend to act swiftly to implement reforms, to then bring about stability and certainty
- Not known which specific elements of the previous detailed plan preparation proposals will be taken forward
- Consultation on NPPF changes and other changes to the planning system July-Sept 2024
- Expecting further consultations over the coming months e.g. National Development Management Policies
