## Certificate of compliance in relation to First Commencement of the Sizewell C Project

On 16 November 2023 East Suffolk Council (ESC) received notice from Sizewell C Limited (SZC Co) of its intention to commence development under the Sizewell C Development Consent Order in addition to notification that the anticipated date for the first commencement of the project (First Commencement) will fall between 04 January 2024 and 31 March 2024.

There are a number of obligations which must be satisfied before First Commencement. The relevant planning obligations are contained within the following documents:

- The Sizewell C Nuclear Power Station Development Consent Order 2022 (DCO);
- The Deed of Obligation entered into by SZC Co, ESC and Suffolk County Council (SCC) dated 08 October 2021 and varied by two deeds of variation dated 13 April 2022 and 06 May 2022 entered into by the same parties (DoO); and
- The Suffolk Environment Charity Deed entered into by ESC, SCC and SZC Co dated 08 October 2021 (Charity Deed).

There are a number of obligations that require ESC's approval or agreement or for specific information to be submitted to the Council prior to First Commencement.

The Appendices to this letter document ESC's certification of SZC Co's compliance with the obligations within the DCO, DoO and Charity Deed in relation to First Commencement.
