SZC PROJECT UPDATE

SZC updated on the current status of the project. The Main Development Site roads package had now been technically approved by Suffolk County Council with that decision being formalised. Construction work will be commencing in the coming weeks. Detailed design approval was also being finalised on both the Sizewell Link Road and Two Village Bypass. Work continues to establish the temporary crossing of the SSSI to the Main Construction Area and initial work will be also commencing on the Temporary Sea Defence.

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DEED OF OBLIGATION Governance

RB reported that the governance oversight of the Deed of Obligation was performing effectively. Meetings for the various governance groups had been fixed for 2025 and meetings held to date have been quorate. Meeting minutes were being approved broadly in line with expected timescales and uploaded to the East Suffolk Council website. Efforts were being made to update the TRG minutes and related reports more quickly after future meetings.

The DSG had been provided with the most recent Minutes of the three Review Groups and there were no escalated issues for consideration.

The Planning Group had previously approved the combination of the SZC Workforce and Transport surveys to be undertaken at the same time. This was endorsed by the DSG.
