## **Project Update**

After starting formal construction this year, the project continues to move forward:

- Orwell Logistics Park has been secured as the new location for Sizewell C's Freight Management Facility (FMF), which will ensure a controlled pattern of deliveries to Sizewell C, enabling reduced movements during peak or sensitive hours.
- Key contracts have been signed Sizewell C reached another significant milestone signing major contracts:
  - Walter Tosto, a leading global player in the manufacturing of top-quality, high-pressure equipment and vessels. The multi-million pound contract with the Italian company is for the supply of critical heat exchangers for the Nuclear Island.
  - Celeros Flow Technology, a global leader in flow control systems, having previously worked with HPC on the provision of nuclear pumps.




# Community Communication

Enquiries this month – 92 July to date

- 1167 enquiries YTD 45% of enquires are of a positive sentiment (with 40% neutral and 15% negative)
- Enquiries this month have maintained a positive focus on jobs, the Noise Mitigation Scheme, accommodation and supply chain
- For July 52% of enquires are of a positive sentiment (with 33% neutral and 15% negative)

#### **Traffic Routes**










## **Weekly Delivery Coordination Meetings**





#### **Rail Overview**




#### **DCO Requirements:**

- Rail infrastructure works to enable delivery of materials to SZC site by rail, thus reducing number of HGVs and impact on local community (Each train removes 46 HGVs from local roads – up to 1000 / week)
- Overnight trains to avoid disruption to other rail services
- Materials from across country, held at Ipswich, until after last passenger train; then journeys from Ipswich to site for offloading and back
- Rail noise mitigation plan acceptance by local authority

#### **Noise & Vibration Impact Mitigation:**

- Design to avoid trains stopping / starting en-route
- Replace jointed track with continuous welded rail
- 10 mph running in urban areas & branchline
- Trains not permitted through Leiston at night (11pm to 7am)



## **Transport Monitoring Reporting**




Review has been undertaken for year-to-date vehicle movements as per CTMP requirements. The trend for two-way HDV movements to the MDS compared to movement caps is as follows:



#### **Question:**

From reading the minutes of the Southern Forum on 14th May, the Sizewell C Traffic Group intend to issue a definitive list of which local routes they will monitor traffic levels. When will this list be made available?

#### **Question:**

At the last meeting it was agreed that a dedicated forum would be set up to include Parish Council representatives to discuss concerns about train noise and the mitigation measures. When will this forum meet?



Submitted by Cllr Richard Cooper, Little Glemham and Marlesford Parish Council:

#### **Question:**

Little Glemham and Marlesford are very concerned about the cumulative noise and vibration impacts of Sizewell C traffic and that of other energy projects, on properties close to the A12. On 11th October 2023 Cllr Sally Noble and I met with Richard Bull at the home of a Marlesford couple. We subsequently sent a detailed listing of the 42 Little Glemham and Marlesford properties within 20m of the A12 (see attached) to Sizewell C Co on 3rd January this year. We have sent several follow-up e mails and have raised the matter in person, but we have seen no substantive progress. We now want SZC Co to acknowledge that there is the potential for adverse impacts and to properly carry out the necessary baseline studies of noise and vibration that would allow benchmarking of impacts once SZC (and other projects) commence in earnest. Will they make that acknowledgement at this meeting?



Submitted by Cllr Richard Cooper, Little Glemham and Marlesford Parish Council:

#### **Question:**

On behalf of the parishes affected by the Southern Park and Ride:

At our meeting on 2nd July, SZC Co indicated that they were unwilling to share drawings of the Southern Park and Ride Site until after they had been shown at the Southern Transport Forum. Can we now assume that following this meeting, parishes will be supplied with appropriately sized drawings that can be reviewed by the respective parish councils?



Submitted by Klaus Fortmann, Clerk, Campsea Ashe Parish Council:

#### **Question:**

Campsea Ashe PC (with considerable SCC support) spent over £20k on a TRO to regulate traffic through a particular village lane.

Today, 6th Aug, four lorries used that road by 10.30 am; despite the TRO being in place, vehicles are using unsuitable roads and it creates considerable anxiety about the expected wave of traffic emanating from SZWC and the other energy projects as well as general traffic that will use 'alternative' routes to reach their destinations.

Lanes & roads such as the B1078 (east of A12, leading to Tunstall) around Campsea are barely suitable for lorries or larger volumes of cars. How is SCC and SZWC ensuring that volumes are 'kept' at an acceptable level and that traffic linked to SZWC is not utilising those lanes? How is SZW monitoring this and if not - why not?



Submitted by Klaus Fortmann, Clerk, Campsea Ashe Parish Council:

#### **Question:**

It has been brought to our attention that Bentwaters is attempting to 'engage' with SZWC related business, meaning to host contractors in the supply chain; how exactly is currently not clear. The A1152 at Melton cross roads is according to WSP (assessment for the 2020 local plan) at capacity.

Neighbouring villages are already complaining and dealing with constant issues relating to traffic / road suitability.

With Tunstall and Campsea (& Eyke) specifically having major road width issues, what - if any - is the strategy of SZWC and SCC?

We were promised that SZWC would not utilise Bentwaters - was that an empty promise?
