Public Notice of Application to redesignate the Melton Neighbourhood Area as approved by the former Suffolk Coastal District Council on 24th December 2013.

Notice is hereby given under the Neighbourhood Planning Act 2017 Section 5 that Melton Parish Council has submitted an application to the East Suffolk Council to redesignate the Melton Neighbourhood Plan Area.

Purpose of the Redesignation:

The application seeks to redesignate the previously approved neighbourhood area. The reason for this redesignation is to remove land at Melton Hill (former Council offices) following a parish boundary change in 2023 which saw the land mentioned above become part of the parish of Woodbridge. A map identifying the area is available for inspection.
