

Mutford Neighbourhood Plan

Consultation period: 26 April to 7 June 2019

Mutford Parish Council have submitted their neighbourhood plan to East Suffolk Council ahead of it being submitted for independent examination. East Suffolk Council is required to publicise the Plan and invite representations, which will be forwarded to the examiner for consideration alongside the plan.

Subject to the plan successfully completing all the relevant regulatory stages, the policies and proposals contained in the plan will be used by East Suffolk Council in the determination of planning applications within the Parish of Mutford.

All representations should be headed Mutford Neighbourhood Plan as the subject matter. Where representations relate to a particular paragraph or policy please ensure that this is also clearly stated. Any representations made may include a request to be notified of East Suffolk Council's decision whether to accept the Examiners' recommendation and future progress with the plan.

When must I submit my representation by?

Representations must be received no later than 5pm on **Friday 7th June 2019**. All representations will be made available to view online as soon as possible after the close of the consultation.
