We live in Friday street and have done for the last 4 years. We are along the road and down a track that goes down to the field on the very southern edge of the proposed plan.

I feel that Friday Street is a small Hamlet in its own right and that inclusion in the larger Rendlesham community would swamp its identity. Postally we have Rendlesham in our Adress (historic legacy and Rendlesham was more the old town and the new Rendlesham was the US airbase)

I was also under the understanding that our house was right on the edge of the parish boundary with Eyke - if not over it - dependent on which map you look at.It would be good to look at that further. I looked at this when we first moved in and boundary ran along the edge of the field.

We would like to see Friday Street as a stand alone community / hamlet or if not in Eykes boundary.

#### Do you have any further comments that you would like to make?

When applying for schools our first catchment school was Eyke. I have heard rumours that the Rendlesham community would be excluded from the Farlingaye School catchment area as that community is growing so fast so that too would affect us and our two children in the future.

Both our Children are at Woodbridge Primary which is giving them a good

multicultural and wider community education and it would be good to continue that at Farlingaye. The proposed Maharishi Free School at Rendlesham would not feature on our choice for our childrens education and we would not wish our children to not have the chance to progress onwards to the school we hope they will enter for the sake of a few 100 yards either way on the map and an arbitrary neighbourhood area. Rendlesham itself is 300 houses short of framlingham and we prefer living in the country to a small town.

We would prefer to be categorised outside the Rendlesham Neighbourhood area. There has been some mild conflict between dog walkers from the Rendleham and a huge volume of traffic down our small lane so that too affects our desire not to be within the neighbourhood area

We enjoy living in a small local community and feel we would be swamped within the larger Rendlesham Area.
